

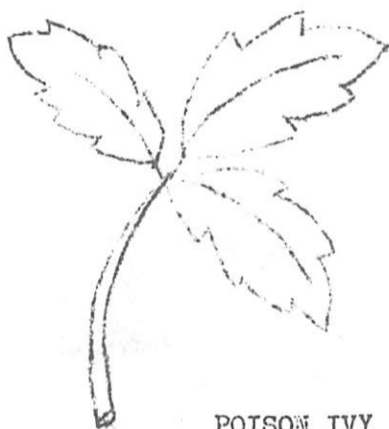
FLOWERS

For your safety, secure your valuables while hiking, tell someone of your plans, and take along a friend.

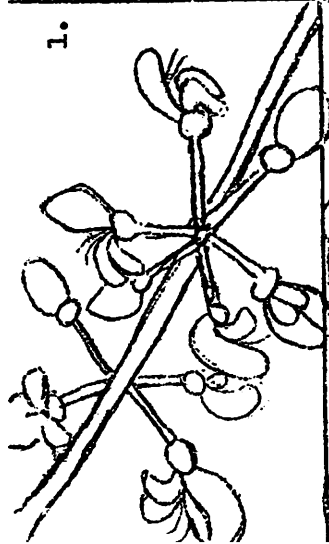
Also be aware of poison ivy/oak. This vine grows along the ground and on trees in open wooded areas. Those allergic to it break out with an itching rash.

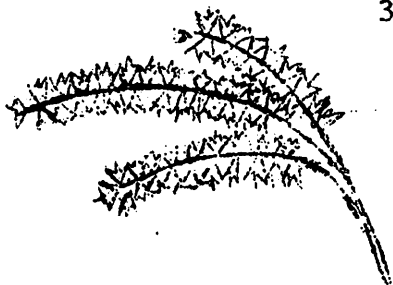
