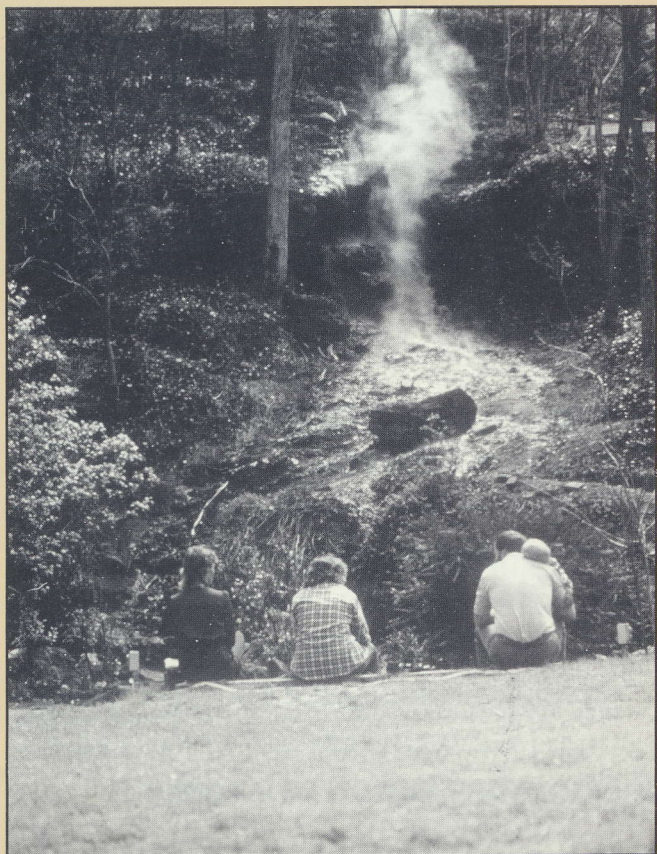
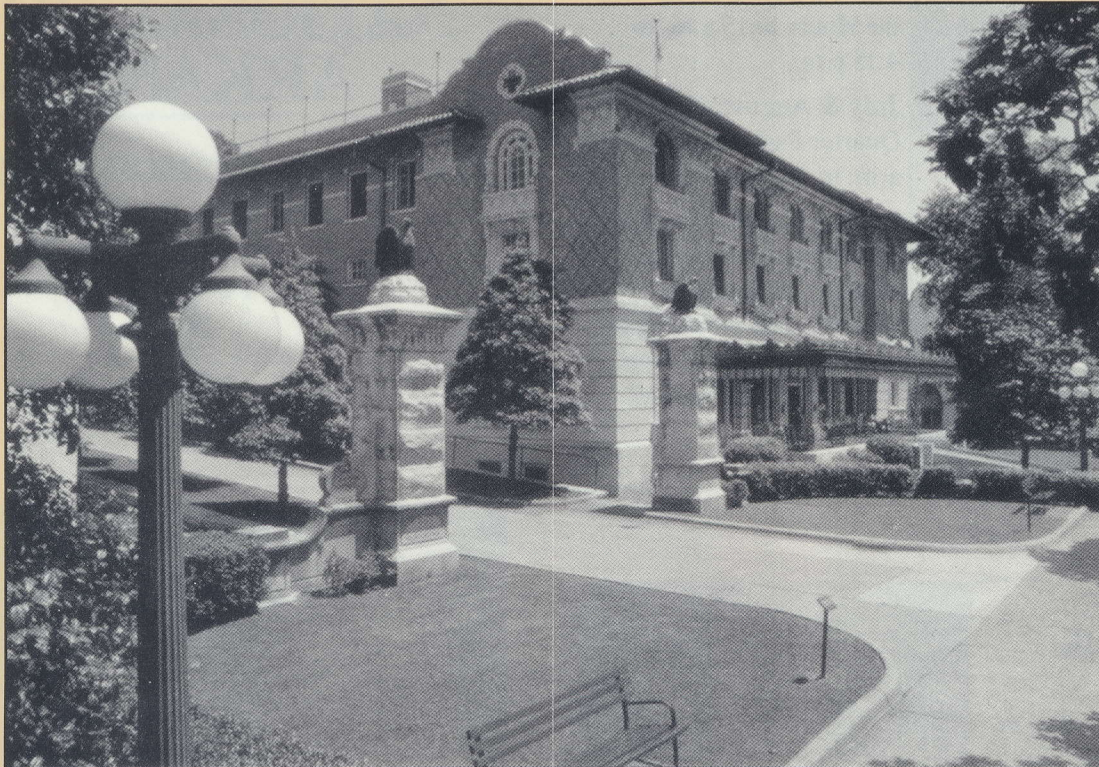

Enter into the atmosphere of the American Spa in the center of Bathhouse Row:

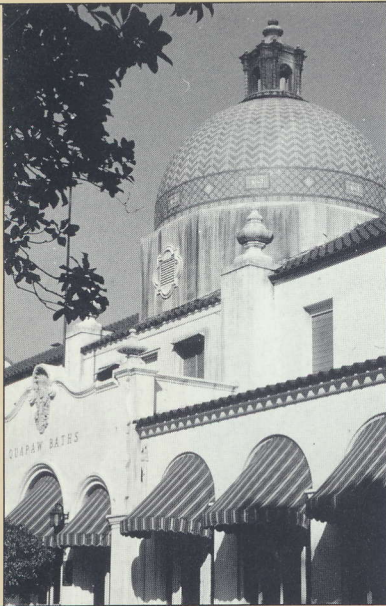

June: Daily: Quarter Past the Hour: 10:15 a.m. to 4:15 p.m.

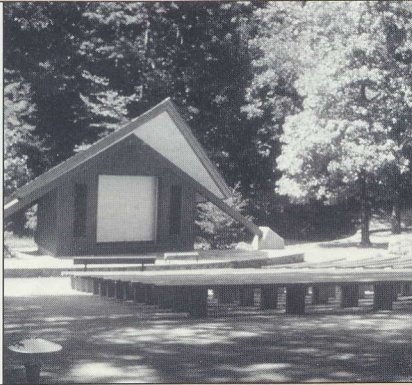
July & August: Daily: Quarter Past the Hour: 8:15 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.
