African Americans were the main workforce for the bathhouses in Hot Springs National Park and the city of Hot Springs, Arkansas. Before integration in the 1960s, due to local laws, they could not be customers in those bathhouses. If they wanted a bath treatment, they had to go to an African American-owned bathhouse.
