### Camping Information

- · Stays are limited to 14 days in a 30-day period.
- · Quiet hours are 10 pm to 6 am. Please be considerate of others.
- · All tents and equipment must be on the camping pad.
- All vehicles/R.V. campers must remain completely on the pavement.
- Pets must be attended, caged, or on a leash of a maximum length of 6 feet.

### Interagency Passes Available to the Public


The National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Interagency Senior and Access passes provide camping discounts at the national park.

### **Prohibited Activities**

- Driving over 15 MPH on camp ground roads
- · Bicycles/vehicles off paved roads
- Campfires outside of provided grates
- Damaging of trees by driving nails, cutting /chopping
- Bathing/washing at water outlets
- Disturbing/hunting/capturing wild life or plants
- Fireworks
- Burning trash in campfires, especially plastics



### **Facilities**

- 66 campsites: 53 conventional drive-in sites; 13 tent only
- Wheelchair accessible sites 15, 30, 41, and 55
- Restrooms and showers (one in each loop)
- · No electric hookups
- · Some sites have limited recreational vehicle length

#### Fees

All sites are \$25.00 per night. Fees are reduced 50% for holders of Interagency Senior or Access passes. All sites reserved online at recreation.gov. See other side for details.

#### Season

April 1st through October 31st.

### Services

Lake Michigan is located 1.5 miles north of the campground. Several beach access points are within easy driving distance. Convenience stores and a gas station are located ¼ mile north of the campground at the intersection of U.S. 12 and Broadway. The Beverly Shores stop of the South Shore Railroad, with passenger service to Chicago and South Bend, is located on Broadway, ¼ mile north of the campground.
