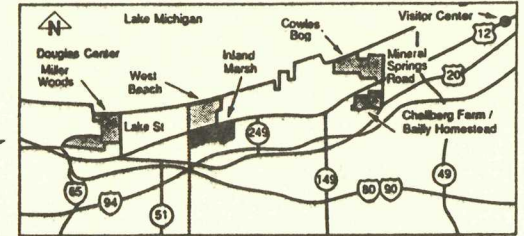
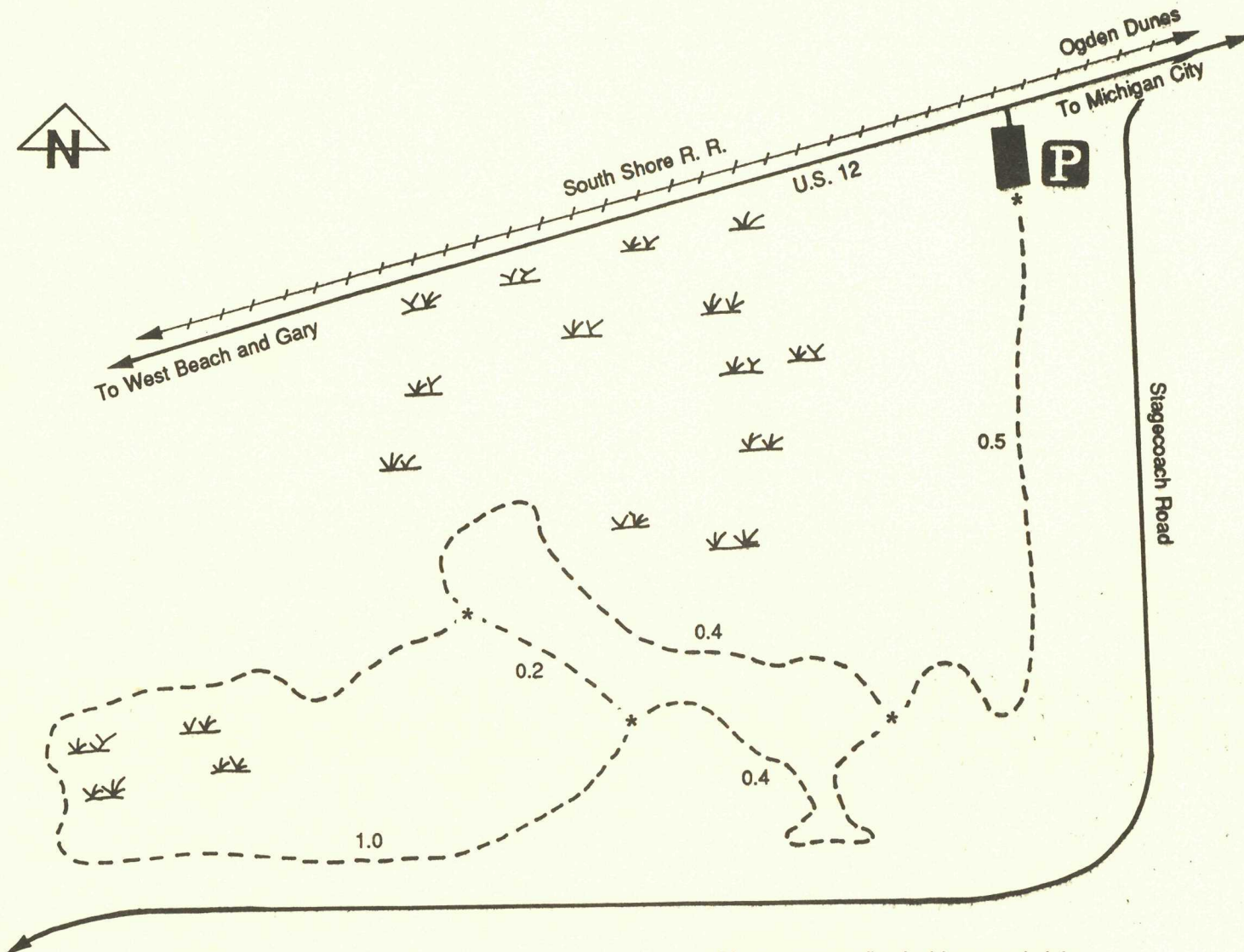

INLAND MARSH TRAILS



This scenic trail skirts the edge of the Great Marsh, the narrow band of wetland between Michigan City and Gary. The trail leads over the high ridges of the Tolleston Dunes, formed about 10,000 years ago when Lake Michigan was 25 feet higher than it is today.

Visitors are asked to stay on the trail and to refrain from picking wildflowers or disturbing animal habitats. Have a pleasant walk.
