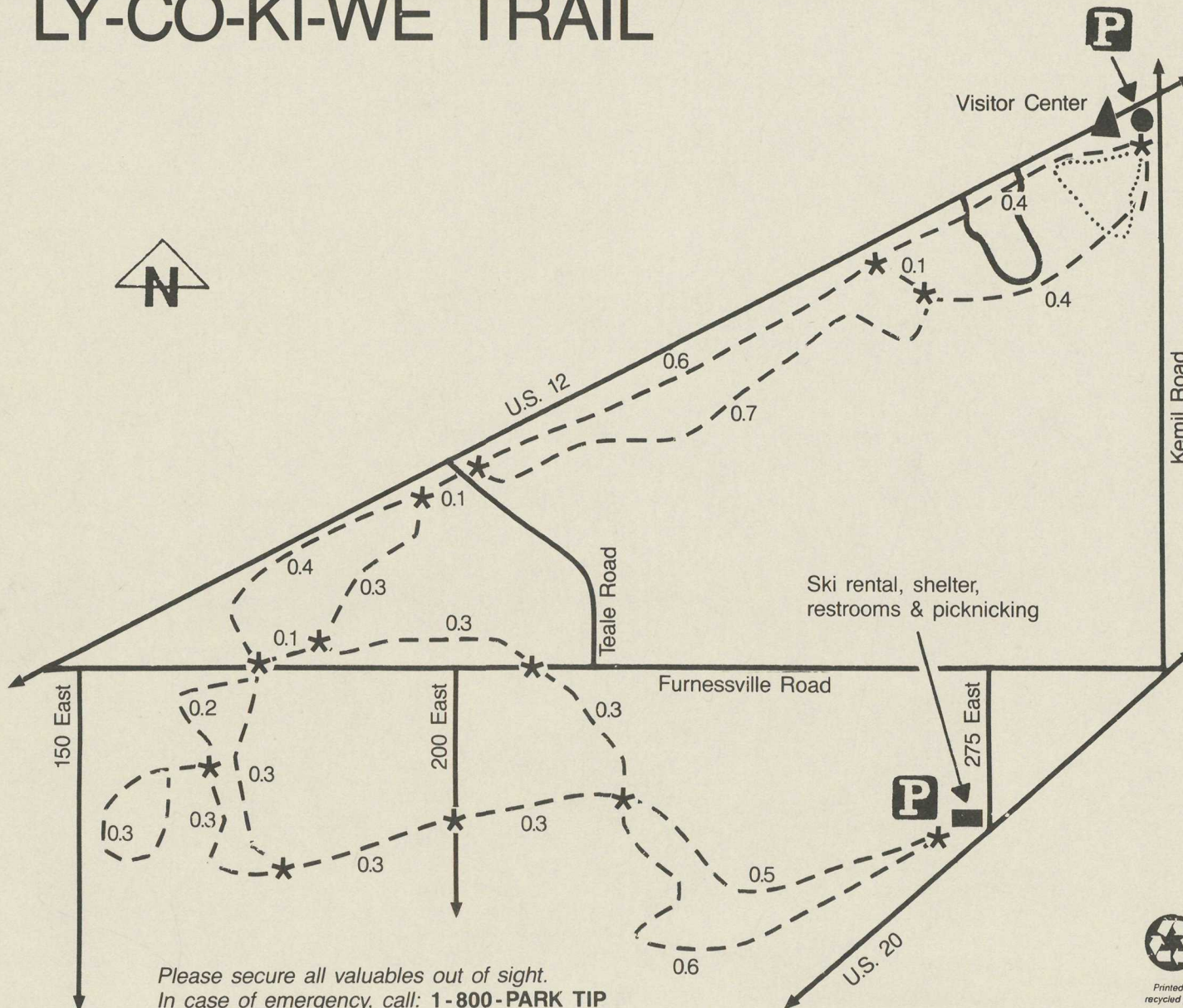


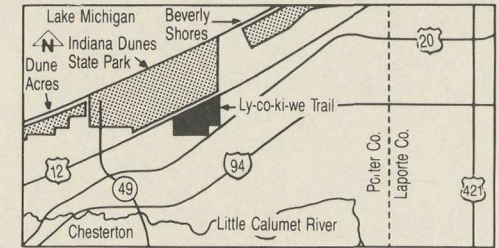

Ly-co-ki-we is a Miami Indian word meaning "sandy ground". The Ly-co-ki-we trail, with loops ranging from 1 - 6 miles in length, can be used for hiking and horseback riding during warmer months, and cross-country skiing in the winter. The trail crosses two dune ridges separated by a wetland which were created as Lake Michigan waters receded.
