# Plan your visit and buy tickets ahead at gatewayarch.com

For the remainder of construction, all visitors entering the Gateway Arch facility must have either a timed tram ride or an entry-only ticket. Timed entry-only tickets will be required through June 30, 2018.

**NOTE:** The new Museum will open in July 2018. During construction, free museum exhibits are available at the Old Courthouse.

Through June 30, 2018, the Old Courthouse is serving as the Gateway Arch Ticketing and Visitor Center. Beginning July 1, 2018, all ticketing will be available inside the Gateway Arch facility.

Parking

The Gateway Arch has no dedicated parking. Please visit **getaroundstl.com** for a list of preferred parking locations in downtown St. Louis.

Accessibility

Except for the Tram Ride to the Top, all facilities at the Gateway Arch are wheelchair accessible. Assisted listening, captioning and audio description devices are available for the documentary movie. Most of the first floor of the Old Courthouse is wheelchair accessible, but the upper floors are reachable only by stairs.

Metro Transit

When taking MetroLink to the Gateway Arch, exit at the 8th & Pine Station, then visit the Old Courthouse for tickets.



Rich with history, the building also features three exhibit galleries telling the story of Lewis & Clark, Native Americans, and colonial St. Louis.
