HUNTERS' INFORMATION

As the nation's primary preservation agency, the National Park Service is dedicated to the protection of all park resources, including wildlife. John Day Fossil Beds National Monument, in fulfilling its mandate to preserve and protect, enforces regulations established in the Code of Federal Regulations (Title 36).





ATTENTION HUNTERS: There is no hunting* allowed within John Day Fossil Beds National Monument. Please refer to the map on the reverse indicating monument boundaries and relevant phone numbers.

* (As defined by Federal regulation, hunting means "taking or attempting to take wildlife." <u>Take</u> or <u>taking</u> means to pursue, hunt, harass, harm, shoot, trap, net, capture, collect, kill, wound, or attempt to do any of the above mentioned acts.)

The following items (a partial listing) are prohibited!


- The taking of wildlife
- Possessing unlawfully taken wildlife or portions thereof
- Using artificial lights to view wildlife in a closed area
- Display of wildlife carcass or other parts thereof
- Possessing, carrying,
 weapons, traps or nets.....
- Improper transportation of weapons ***....
- Carrying or possessing a loaded weapon in a motor vehicle


A person convicted of violating any of these prohibitions shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or by imprisonment not exceeding 6 months, or both, and shall be adjudged to pay all costs of the proceedings.

*** Unloaded weapons may be possessed within a vehicle when weapons are rendered temporarily inoperable or packed, cased or stored in a manner which will prevent their ready use.


Camping or off-road travel with vehicles within the monument is prohibited.

NOTE: All lands adjacent to John Day Fossil Beds National Monument are either privately owned or managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). The maps below should be used as a general indicator of monument land locations and boundaries. More accurate area BLM and USFS maps may be purchased at the monument visitor center and local BLM and USFS offices.






Clarno Unit
