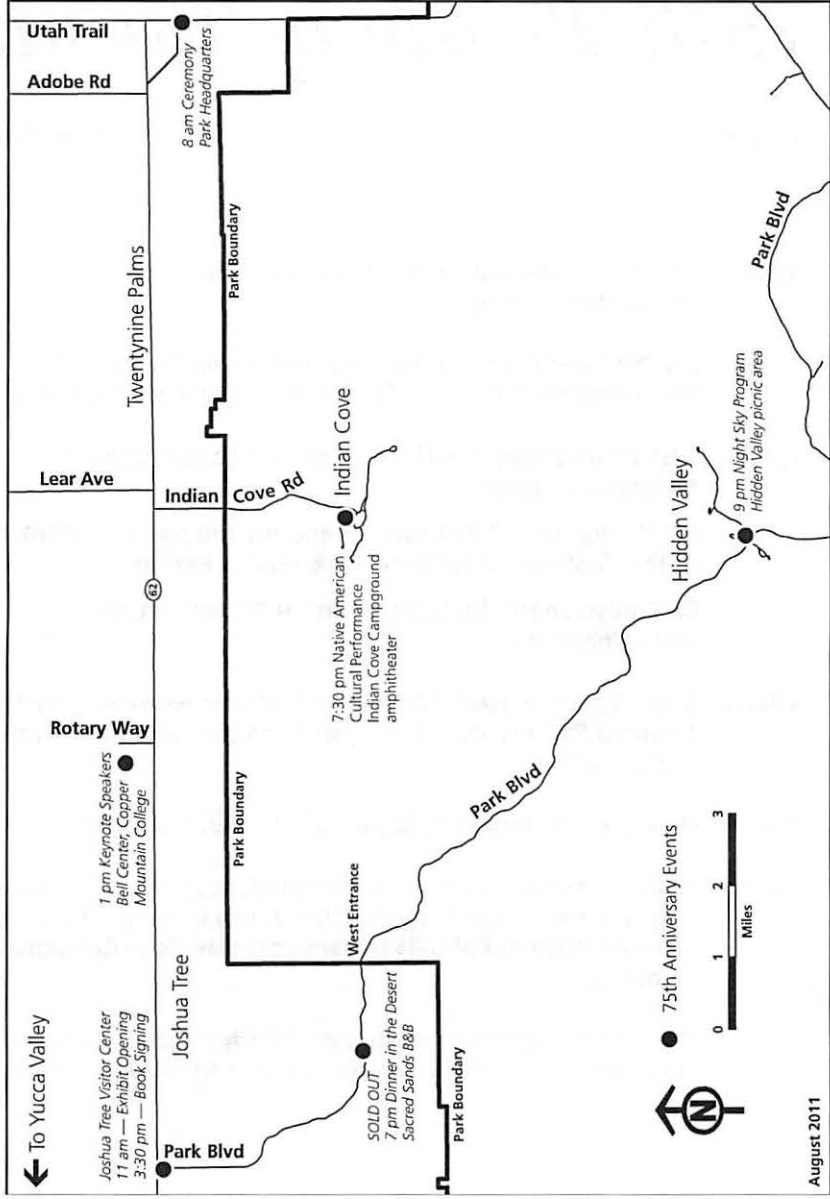


Location Map for 75th Anniversary Events
