

Trammer's Tour

For all ages

Length: 1 hr.

All Times are Eastern Time Zone Tour offered until 5:00pm

- Travel underground on the same gravel paths the miners used years ago to reach a scenic overlook
- Experience stopes- whole rooms carved out by hand in search of copper
- View natural copper, still in the rock
- Hear tales of mining life and descriptions of historic tools and working conditions





Prospector's Tour Moderate For all ages Length: 1hr. 30 min. Tour offered until 4:30pm

- Travel underground over small rocks and up slight slopes through the full length of the first level of the mine
- Experience stopes with ceilings up to 300 feet
- View large masses of natural copper, embedded in the rock walls
- The Prospector's Tour builds on all of the locations and descriptions of the introductory Trammer's Tour





Min. age of 13 Miner's Tour Challenging Length: 2-3 hrs. Tour offered until 3:00pm and weight of 70 lbs

- Follow the path of our Prospector's Tour but then finish by rappelling down an 80 foot shaft to the 2nd mine level
- Experience the Ice Cave
- View some of the oldest parts of the mine and historic surface features not available on shorter tours
- The Miner's Tour offers an authentic historic and physical underground experience





Captain's Tour Very Challenging Min. age of 13 yrs. Length: 5-6 hrs. Tour by reservation only

- Travel several miles underground to areas of the second level that have been submerged since the 1920's
- This is a very unique and physically intense experience that offers areas of the mine that are nearly unexplored
- Tour departs at 10:00am, a traditional underground lunch of local pasties is included
- RESERVATIONS REQUIRED Minimum of two participants. Seasonal tour: access may restrict availability until July 1st.
