## **Carnegie Museum of the Keweenaw**

Located in the former public library building on the corner of Huron and Montezuma streets in historic downtown Houghton, Michigan, the Carnegie Museum features changing exhibits and programs about the region's cultural and natural history.

The two-story sandstone and brick building opened in 1910 and served as the community library for almost a century. It has housed the Carnegie Museum since 2007.
