The Copper Range Mining Company was one of the largest, longest-lived and most profitable mining companies in the Keweenaw region. Around the mines and their associated operations, communities developed in southern Houghton County. Though the mines have since closed and some of the communities disappeared, the Copper Range Historical Museum helps to create a sense of what life was like during the copper mining boom.
