RANGER-LED ACTIVITIES AT THE PARK

Participate in ranger-led activities on the surface and in the cave. Rangers lead cave trips year-round, except for Christmas Day. During the busy summer season, park rangers offer over twenty different cave and surface activities. School groups may participate in the park's environmental education program by writing or calling Mammoth Cave's Environmental Coordinator for reservations.

Cave tours sell out quickly year round. In order to plan ahead and participate in the tour of your choice, we strongly urge you to make reservations. For all cave tours, you can make reservations through Mistix corporation from two months to one hour in advance of when you wish to tour the cave. Call 1-800-967-CAVE (2283) to make reservations or stop by the Visitor Center.

Tips for planning a cave trip:

The cave temperature is approximately 55 degrees F year round. Dress accordingly.


Wear durable footwear suitable for walking over trails that may be somewhat rough and uneven and/or wet and slippery. Expect numerous stairs and some steep inclines on many cave trips.

Consider your physical limitations realistically when choosing a cave tour. If you fear heights or close places and/or cannot climb steps, enjoy a ranger-led activity on the surface instead!




FEATURES — ACTIVITIES

- **CAMPFIRE PROGRAMS** — By Park Rangers at the Amphitheater and Campground. Conducted nightly during the summer and as scheduled during spring and fall months.
- **RANGER-LED ACTIVITIES** — Visit many spectacular features of Mammoth Cave on trips conducted by National Park Service rangers. Cave trips are conducted daily, except on Christmas Day. Rangers also conduct other activities for children and adults, including nature walks and bus tours.
- **HERITAGE TRAIL** — The Heritage Trail winds through the woods over three-fourths of a mile to Sunset Point. The scenic trail accommodates visitors in wheelchairs. The National Park Service has developed, especially for handicapped persons, a taped interpretive message for the trail. Copies of the tape are available at the visitor center.
- **NATURE TRAILS** — Enjoy walking the nature trails at Sloans Crossing, Cedar Sink, Turnhole Bend, and near the visitor center. For horseback riders and long-distance hiking, explore over 70 miles of trails within the park. A two-mile self-guided motor nature trail follows a primitive road on Joppa Ridge.
- **TENNIS AND SHUFFLEBOARD COURTS** are adjacent to the Mammoth Cave Hotel.
- **CAMPING AND PICNIC AREAS** — are located near Mammoth Cave Hotel. Camping facilities are also located at Houchins Ferry and at Dennison Ferry. Group camping located at Maple Springs and backcountry campsites accommodate backpackers.




OPEN ALL YEAR

MAMMOTH CAVE NATIONAL PARK is located in south-central Kentucky, within one day's drive of 100 million persons.

MAMMOTH CAVE is easily accessible by: Highways I-65, 31W, 31E from the North; Blue Grass Parkway, the Cumberland Parkway and U.S. 68 from the East; I-65, 31W and U.S. 68 from the South; U.S. 231, The Green River Parkway and the Western Kentucky Parkway from the West. All connect with Ky. 70 and Ky. 255 to the park.

BUS — Southeastern Greyhound Buses stop in Cave City. Taxi Service is available from the bus station to the park.

AIR — Major Airlines provide service to Louisville, KY. and Nashville, TN. both less than 100 miles or about 1½ hours drive to Mammoth Cave. Car Rentals are available at each airport.

MAMMOTH CAVE NATIONAL PARK

1814 marked the beginning of hotel service at Mammoth Cave near the historic entrance where Mammoth Cave Hotel now stands. A new travel experience awaits you where tasty regional foods and traditional hospitality welcomes you to Mammoth Cave National Park. The world's longest network of cavern corridors, over 330 miles in length, is located beneath picturesque hills and valleys. Mammoth Cave offers the thrill of adventure in its extensive avenues where you can see colorful stalactites and stalagmite formations, huge cavern rooms and spectacular pits and domes. Mammoth Cave is one of America's most famous attractions. The cave may be visited every day of the year (except Christmas Day) and is equally enjoyable in winter or summer since the cave temperature fluctuates very little with the seasons (approximately 55 degrees). Remember to explore the park on top of Mammoth Cave too! With 80 square miles of forested hills and bluffs, 30 miles of scenic rivers and 70 miles of trails, you will find countless opportunities for walking, hiking, canoeing, and boating. Excellent accommodations are available for your comfort at reasonable rates. You will receive a hospitable welcome and enjoy a rich and rewarding experience during your Mammoth Cave National Park vacation.

- **MAMMOTH CAVE HOTEL** — A luxurious brick motor-hotel overlooking a scenic ravine, near the Historic Entrance to Mammoth Cave and connected to the National Park Visitor Center by an arched concrete bridge. The Mammoth Cave Hotel is completely air-conditioned, with wall-to-wall carpeting, tiled shower and tub baths, television, private patios and balconies.
- **SUNSET POINT MOTOR LODGE** — Located near the Hotel at the edge of the forest overlooking the Sunset Point Bluffs. Spacious rooms with well appointed furnishings, two double beds, TV, air-conditioning, electric heat, wall-to-wall carpet, tiled shower and tub bath.
- **HOTEL COTTAGES** — Located adjacent to the Hotel. Early American furnishings, air-conditioning, electric heat, wall-to-wall carpet, shower bath. (March 1 to November 1)
- **WOODLAND COTTAGES** — Cottages are located in the forest a short distance from the Hotel and provide the vacation privacy families enjoy in national parks. Individual cottages, two room cottages and three and four room cottages. (May 15 to October 1)

(No overnight room accommodations are equipped with cooking facilities)

- **GIFT AND CRAFT SHOPS** — A wide selection of gifts and Kentucky Crafts as well as handmade crafts by the Southern Highland Craft members and other skilled craftsmen. - **HOTEL DINING ROOM AND COFFEE SHOP** — Excellent southern regional foods are served in an attractive Dining Room and Coffee Shop, where hospitality, fine food and courteous service are a tradition. Open daily from 7:00 A.M. to 7:30 P.M.
- **SERVICE CENTER** — A centrally located Service Center is convenient to the Camping Area, Hotel and the Visitor Center. Facilities include — Service Station, Ice Vendor, Camping and Picnic Supplies, Groceries, Self-Service Laundry, Showers, Gift, Telephones and the U.S. Post Office. Located adjacent to the Camping Area. — Open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Open on weekends from Easter to Memorial Day and from Labor Day to mid-October.
- **GROUP MEETING FACILITIES** including private dining rooms, are available for group meetings and conferences from September through April. Up to 160 persons can be accommodated. The park is especially enjoyable in the Spring, Fall and Winter and meetings at the Mammoth Cave Hotel are well attended. The Hotel offers excellent banquet facilities and meeting rooms where you can enjoy our hospitality and friendly service at reasonable rates. Natural attractions of the National Park provides a refreshing atmosphere for group meetings.
- **WESTERN UNION TELEGRAPH SERVICE** ... Mammoth Cave, Kentucky.
- **WILDLIFE** — White-tailed deer are frequently seen along the park roads. 200 species of birds as well as other wildlife are found in the park.
- **VISITOR CENTER** is open daily (except Christmas Day) throughout the year. The movie *Voices of the Cave*, is shown throughout the day at no charge.




