FROZEN NIAGARA — One-hour Guided Tour — \$1.50 per adlut. Stalactites, Stalagmites and other cave formations. (Children under 16 and holders of Golden Age Passports — \$1.00)

HALF-DAY TOUR — Four-hour Guided Trip — \$2.50 per adult — Food service in Snowball Room, Gypsum, Stalactites, Stalagmites, and long winding passages. (Children under 16 and holders of Golden Age Passports — \$1.50.)

HISTORIC — Two-hour Guided Trip (Self-guided in summer) — \$1.50 per adult. Mammoth Dome, Largest Cave Rooms, and Historic Features. (Children under 16 and holders of Golden Age Passports — 75c.)

Cave trips offered daily all year, (except Christmas Day). Check current schedule at Visitor Center or at Hotel Front Office upon arrival.

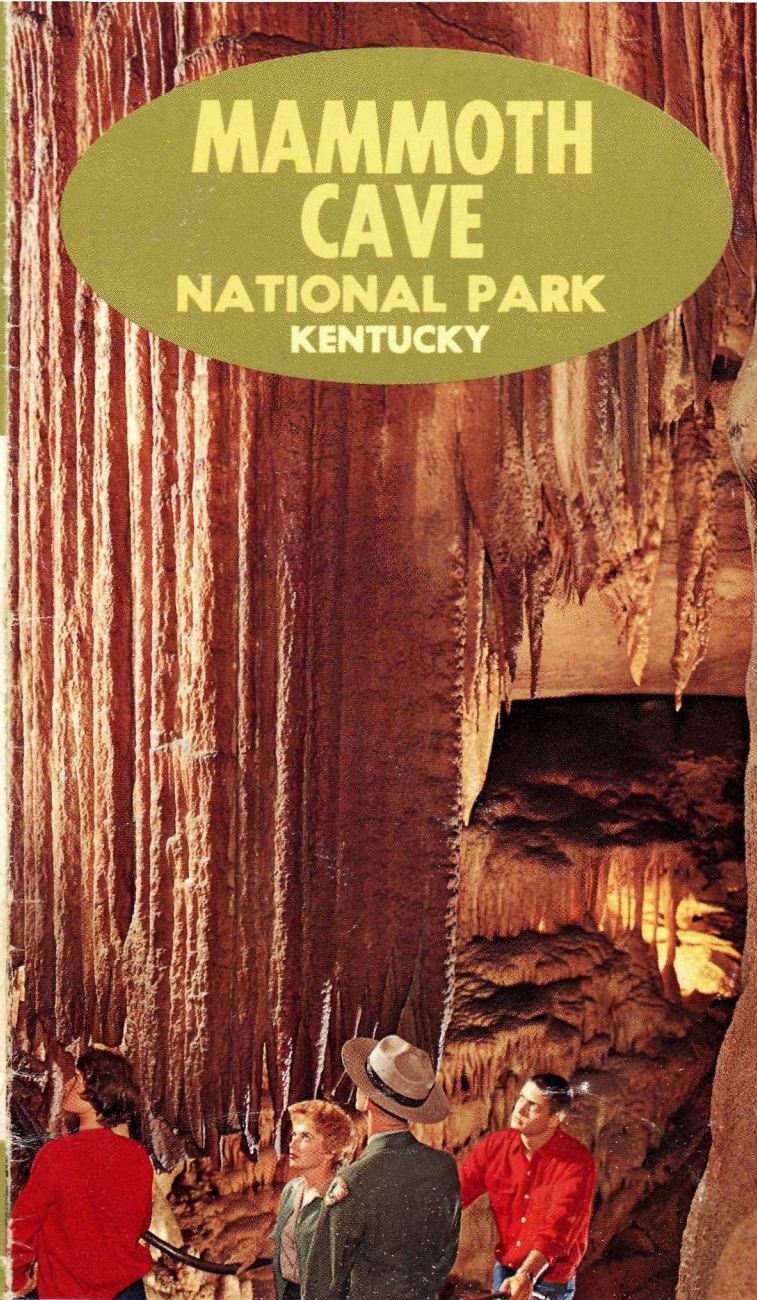

**MAMMOTH CAVE HOTEL AND NATIONAL PARK VISITOR CENTER
FEATURES — ACTIVITIES**

- **CAMPFIRE PROGRAMS** — By Park Interpreters at the Amphitheater and Campground Scheduled nightly during the summer and reduced schedule during spring and fall.
- **CAVE TOURS** — The many spectacular features of Mammoth Cave are shown by conducted tours under the direction of National Park Service Guides. Frequent tours are conducted daily throughout the year except Christmas Day. The length of trips vary from 1 hour to 6 hours.
- **NATURE TRAILS** — Guided (in Summer) and self-guided Scenic Trails lead through dense woodlands and along the picturesque Green River bluffs. A two mile motor nature trail, with illustrated leaflet, follows a primitive road on Joppa Ridge. Naturalist conducted walks over a variety of park trails scheduled daily during summer; reduced schedule during spring and fall.
- **SCENIC BOAT TRIPS ON GREEN RIVER** — Frequent cruises daily, April-Oct. See park wilderness and wildlife.
- **TENNIS AND SHUFFLEBOARD COURTS** are adjacent to the Mammoth Cave Hotel.
- **CAMPING AND PICNIC AREAS** — An improved campground and picnic area are provided for park visitors.
- **LIVE HANDICRAFT EXHIBITS** — June to September.



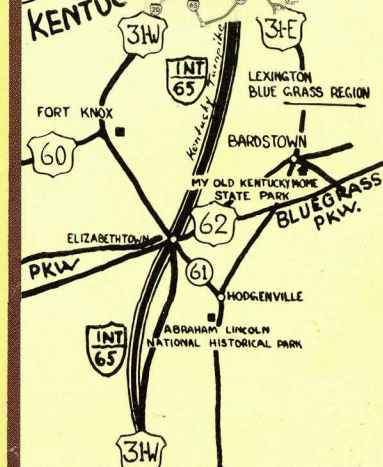
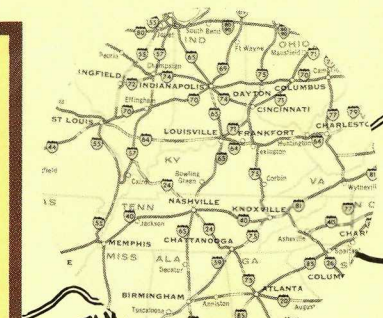
It's Easy to Reach

MAMMOTH CAVE NATIONAL PARK is located in south-central Kentucky, within one day's drive of 100,000,000 persons.

MAMMOTH CAVE is easily accessible by: Highways I-65, 31W, 31E from the North; Blue Grass Parkway, the Cumberland Parkway and U.S. 68 from the East; I-65, 31W and U.S. 68 from the South; U. S. 231, The Green River Parkway and the Western Kentucky Parkway from the West. All connect with Ky. 70 and Ky. 255 to the park.

BUS — Southeastern Greyhound Buses stop in Cave City. Taxi Service is available from the bus station to the park.

AIR — Commercial Air Lines provide daily service to Bowling Green, 35 miles from Mammoth Cave National Park. Car rentals may be arranged at the airport.

OPEN ALL YEAR — European Plan

- **MAMMOTH CAVE HOTEL** — A luxurious brick motor-hotel overlooking a scenic ravine, near the Historic Entrance to Mammoth Cave and connected to the National Park Visitor Center by an arched concrete bridge. The Mammoth Cave Hotel is completely air-conditioned, with wall-to-wall carpeting, tiled shower and tub baths, television, private patios and balconies. A spacious, inviting lounge creates an atmosphere for relaxation. The distinctive gift shops feature authentic native Kentucky and Southern Highland Handicrafts, quality gifts, souvenirs, and a wide selection of photographic supplies, color slides and books.
- **SUNSET POINT MOTOR LODGE** — Located near the Hotel at the edge of the forest overlooking the Sunset Point Bluffs. Spacious rooms with well appointed furnishings, two double beds, TV, air-conditioned, electric heat, wall-to-wall carpet, tiled shower and tub bath.
- **HOTEL COTTAGES** — Located adjacent to the Frame Hotel. Early American furnishings, air-conditioned, electric heat, wall-to-wall carpet, shower bath.
- **WOODLAND COTTAGES** — Cottages are secluded in the forest a short distance from the Hotel and provide the vacation privacy families enjoy in national parks. Individual cottages, two room cottages and three and four room cottages.
- **HOTEL ANNEX — CRAFT SHOP** — This frame structure has the early resort hotel charm including an early American fireplace and a large screened front porch. Rooms provide a wide choice of budget accommodations. Live exhibits of broom making and weaving are presented by Berea Students at the Craft Shop during the summer. Craft Shop (open all year) offers a wide selection of handicraft gifts.

(No overnight room accommodations are equipped with cooking facilities)

- **HOTEL DINING ROOM AND COFFEE SHOP** — Excellent southern regional foods are served in an attractive Dining Room and Coffee Shop, where hospitality, fine food and courteous service are a tradition.
- **SERVICE CENTER** — A centrally located Service Center is convenient to the Camping Area, Hotel and the Visitor Center. Facilities include — Service Station, Ice Vendor, Campers and Picnic Supplies, Groceries, Self-Service Laundry, Showers, Refreshments, Gift, Craft and Photo Shops, Telephones and the U. S. Post Office. Located adjacent to the Camping Area.
- **GROUP MEETING FACILITIES**, including private dining rooms, are available for group meetings and conferences from October through April. Up to 175 persons can be accommodated. The park is especially enjoyable in the Spring, Fall and Winter and meetings at the Mammoth Cave Hotel are well attended. The Hotel offers excellent banquet facilities and meeting rooms where you can enjoy our hospitality and friendly service at reasonable rates. Natural attractions of the National Park offer refreshing recreation.
- **WESTERN UNION TELEGRAPH SERVICE** . . . Mammoth Cave, Kentucky.
- **PHOTOGRAPHY** the Cave offers a variety of opportunities for unusual and colorful photographs. However, tripods are not permitted within the Cave. Surface floral displays in spring, the brilliant hues of autumn and the wildlife are a photographic challenge.
- **WILDLIFE** — White-tailed deer are frequently seen along the park roads. 200 species of birds as well as other wildlife are found in the park area.
- **VISITOR CENTER** is open daily (except Christmas Day) throughout the year. Audio-visual orientation slide programs presented frequently during the day.

National Park Concessions, Inc., is authorized by the National Park Service, U.S. Department of the Interior, to serve the public in Mammoth Cave National Park.



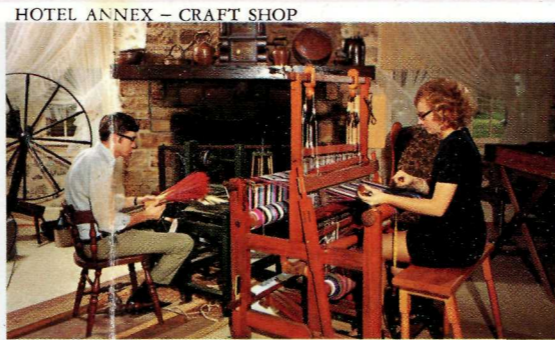

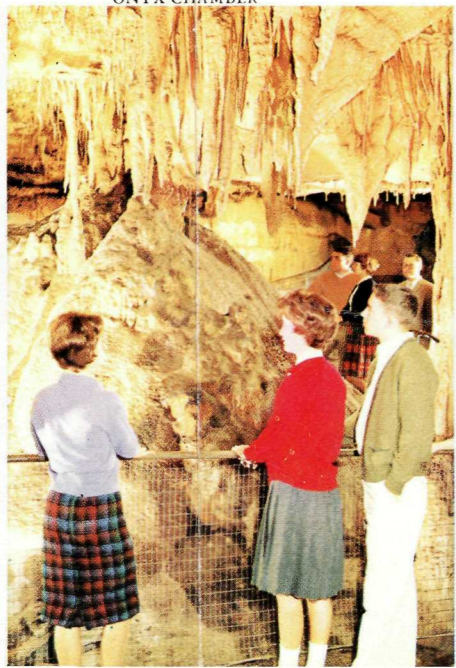

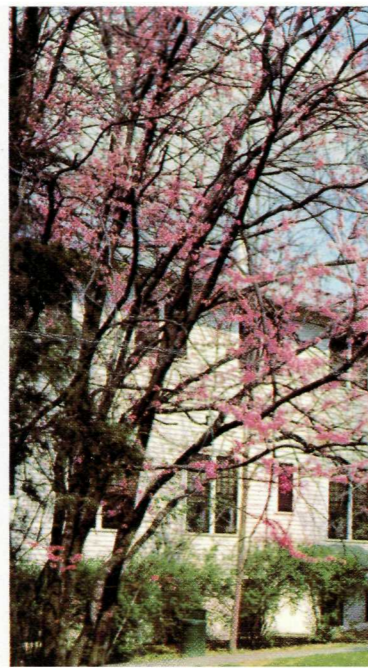
