

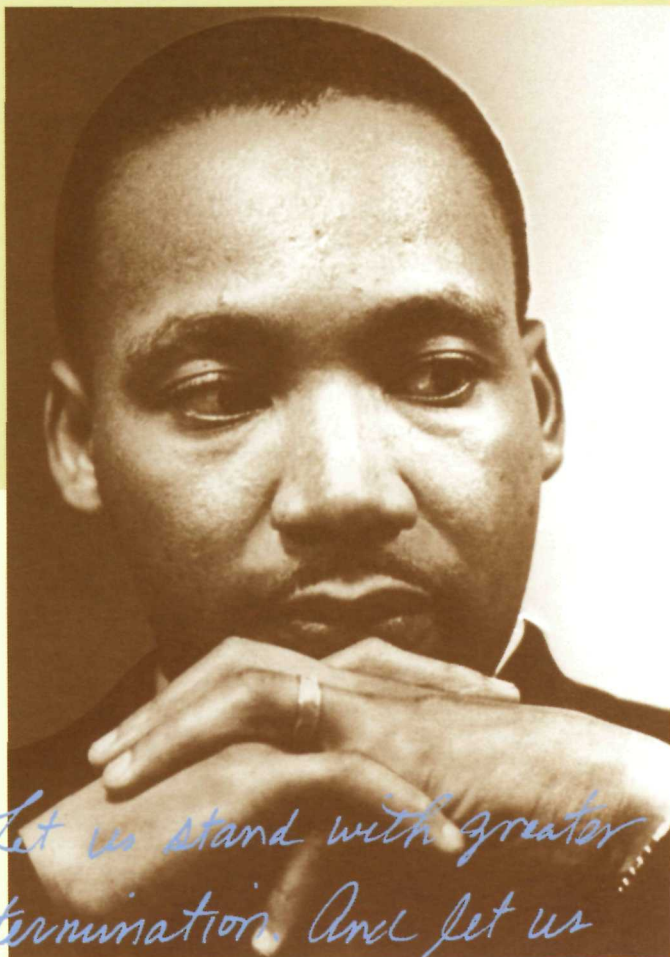

- View King family artifacts including the Nobel Peace Prize.
- Stop at Fire Station No. 6 to learn about the desegregation of the Atlanta Fire Department.
- Tour the birth place and childhood home of Dr. King.
- Walk along the Birth Home Block of historic and fully restored homes.



Directions by car

I-75/85 to Freedom Parkway (Exit 248C). At Boulevard turn right and follow the signs to the Parking Lot.



Directions by Marta

Take the #3 bus at the Marta Five Points Station directly to the park, or take the Marta East Rail Line, exit at the King Memorial Station and follow signs to the park.



Hours: 9am - 5pm daily except Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. Between June 15 - August 15 park hours are 9am - 6pm.

All attractions are free.
