- UPF supports phasing out mission dependency on Y-12's Building 9212, a World War II—era enriched uranium processing facility
- UPF will support the nation's nuclear weapons stockpile by processing enriched uranium in support of nonproliferation
- UPF will provide uranium feedstock to fuel the U.S. Nuclear Navy
- UPF will be completed through a series of seven subprojects—the first two subprojects were completed on time and under budget
- NNSA has committed to deliver UPF for no more than \$6.5B by the end of 2025, assuming stable funding through the duration of the project
- One of the largest construction projects ever in Tennessee, more than 2,000 people will work on the project at the peak of construction
