A collection of short documentary films ranging from the six episodes of *Our Hidden Past* series to the present status of the Y-12 National Security Complex, *This is Y-12* and *The Highly Enriched Uranium Materials Facility*, to a glimpse of the future, *The Uranium Processing Facility*.

SECRET CITY: *The War Years*

A 90-minute documentary film focused on the World War II era and telling the story of all three sites in Oak Ridge, The *K-25 Gaseous Diffusion Plant*, The *Y-12 Plant* (electromagnetic separation) and The *X-10 Graphite Reactor* as well as the *Clinton Engineer Works*.

SECRET CITY: *1945-2006*

A 90-minute documentary film focused on the years after the Manhattan Project (1945 - 2006) and telling the continuing story of Oak Ridge and the Atomic Energy Commission/Department of Energy with emphasis on the winning of the Cold War and sustaining the nation's nuclear weapons capability.

FOUR-PART SERIES A NUCLEAR FAMILY

Four 30-minute episodes made, for East Tennessee Public Broadcasting System, telling the history of the Manhattan Project Clinton Engineer Works' Y-12 electromagnetic separation plant that was later known as the Oak Ridge Y-12 Plant and is now known as the Y-12 National Security Complex.

The four episodes are: *I've Seen it*; *The Manhattan District*; *A Race for Peace*; and *Lifting the Veil*.
