Facts about the Battle of Moores Creek Bridge

- O Moores Creek National Battlefield preserves the site of the first Patriot victory of the American Revolution, fought February 27, 1776.
- O The Battle of Moores Creek Bridge is the site of the last Scottish Highland broadsword charge.
- O The Patriot victory ended British authority in the colony and stalled the British invasion of the South for four and a half years.
- O Shortly after the battle, North Carolina would be the first colony to instruct its delegates to the 1776 Continental Congress to vote for independence by passing the Halifax Resolves.
