Special Order #191

Fact: The lost orders were found by Cpl. Barton Mitchell, who was wounded at Antietam four days later. In Special Order #191, Confederate General Robert F. Lee outlined the plan for dividing his Army of Northern Virginia as it moved into Maryland in September 1862. A lost copy was found by Union soldiers and given to General George McClellan. It was found on the Best farm, which became an important Confederate artillery position at the Battle of Monocacy two years later.
