### ***Henry M. Jackson Memorial Visitor Center***

Located at Paradise, famous for its glorious views and wildflower meadows, the visitor center offers exhibits on geology, glaciers, wildlife, and mountain climbing. Browse through our gift shop and enjoy lunch in the Base Camp Deli. Open daily May through September and weekends from October through April.

### ***Sunrise Day Lodge and Visitor Center***

Located at 6400 feet, Sunrise is the highest point in the park accessible by car. The mountain meadows abound with wildflowers and offer breathtaking views of the volcanoes in the Cascade Range and the Emmons Glacier. Open daily from late June through early September with a gift shop and snack bar available in the day lodge.

## Paradise Inn

### *Paradise Inn*

Built in 1916, this historic guest lodge sits in the shadow of Mount Rainier, surrounded by alpine meadows lush with wildflowers. Miles of hiking trails are just outside the front door with panoramic views of glaciers and waterfalls. The inn features a full service dining room, serving Northwest cuisine, and gift shop with authentic Native American arts and crafts. Open mid May to early October.

### *National Park Inn*

Nestled in the forest of the Longmire Historic District, the Inn provides a restful retreat for visitors to Mount Rainier National Park and is open year round. A full service dining room features Northwest cuisine and a general store is located in a historic 1911 cabin nearby. Relax in front of a roaring fire in our cozy lounge or enjoy spectacular views of Mount Rainier from comfortable chairs on the front porch.
