Log construction, one-story, one-room, rectangular plan; medium-pitched cedar shake gable roof with projecting eaves and verges: stove pipe chimney; log exterior walls with saddle notched corners, rope oakum and wood chinking; casement and fixed sashes; interior contains exposed log trusses and purlins, tongue-and-groove floor; stone rubble foundation; front porch extends full length of building, framed with log posts and beams, dirt floor.

The Huckleberry Creek Patrol Cabin was erected circa 1934. Located north of Sunrise near the park's northern boundary. CCC labor may have been used in hauling materials and constructing the ranger cabin. Between 1933 and 1934 the CCC built a cabin in the Carbon River District at the mouth of Ipsut Creek (see other entry.) They were also probably involved in the construction of the Three Lakes Patrol Cabin in 1934. The Huckleberry Creek cabin measures 13'-8" by 21'-10" and was built similarly to the "Standard Plan for Patrol Cabins" designed by the NPS Western Divsion, Branch of Plans and Design. The major difference between the Huckleberry Creek cabin and the standard plan is the full length open porch extending across its front facade. Containing simply a dirt floor, the porch measures 7'-0" by 21'-10".

A plan to construct ranger cabins and trail shelters around the mountain evolved during the brief superintendency of Roger W. Toll (1919-1920.) This plan was carried between 1922 and 1934 largely during the administration of Superintendent Major O. A. Tomlinson. Acting Chief Architect W. G. Carnes executed the design of the 1930's standard patrol cabin plan. 14 CONDITION



16. SIGNIFICANCE

Huckleberry Creek Patrol Cabin is a component of Superintendent Roger W. Toll's vision of a series of ranger cabins and trail shelters around the mountain. This plan was carried out between 1922 and 1934 largely during Superintendent Tomlinsons's administration (1923-1941.) The cabins and shelters erected in 1933-34 were generally done so with CCC labor. The Huckleberry Creek Cabin, currently unoccupied, is an outstanding example of a NPS standard design and construction for ranger patrol cabins. It is also associated with the early NPS ranger activities at Mount Rainier.
