Interpretive Program Schedule

Navajo National Monument announces its interpretive program schedules for the winter, spring, and fall season. September 12, 2009 marks the end of our summer season.

- The Visitor Center will be open from 9:00am to 5:00pm starting September 27, 2009 for the fall, winter, and spring season and return to 8:00am to 5:00 on May 30, 2009.
- Betatakin tours will be at 10:00am, seven days a week until September 30th, 2009. Starting October 1, the Betatakin tour will be available on Saturday, Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursdays at 10:00am, and weather permitting. Other daily interpretive programs will be made available as scheduled for visitors who are unable to make the hiking tours. Reservations are not needed
- Keet Seel has ended its summer season on September 12th, 2009. Fall hikes will be offered on October 10 and 11, November 14 and 15, and on December 5 and 6, 2009. Please be advised that overnight will be available on the first day or the Saturdays of each scheduled weekend program and day hikes are only available on the second day or the Sundays of the scheduled weekends.
