Northern pocket gopher, <i>Thomomys talpoides</i>	Rare
Deer mouse, <i>Peromyscus maniculatus</i>	Abundant
Bushy-tailed woodrat, <i>Neotoma cinerea</i>	Common locally
Heather vole, <i>Phenacomys intermedius</i>	Common locally
Redback vole, <i>Clethrionomys gapperi</i>	Common
Townsend vole, <i>Microtus townsendi</i>	Common
Long-tailed vole, <i>Microtus longicaudus</i>	Uncommon
Oregon vole, <i>Microtus oregoni</i>	Common locally
Western jumping mouse, <i>Zapus princeps</i>	Common
Coyote, <i>Canis latrans</i>	Common
Wolf, <i>Canis lupus</i>	Extinct
Red fox, <i>Vulpes fulva</i>	Rare (introduced)
Black bear, <i>Ursus americanus</i>	Common
Raccoon, <i>Procyon lotor</i>	Common
Marten, <i>Martes americana</i>	Common locally
Fisher, <i>Martes pennanti</i>	Rare (extinct?)
Short-tailed weasel, <i>Mustela erminea</i>	Common
Long-tailed weasel, <i>Mustela frenata</i>	Common
Mink, <i>Mustela vison</i>	Common

Spotted skunk, <i>Spilogale putorius</i>	Common
Striped skunk, <i>Mephitis mephitis</i>	Common

Sea otter, <i>Enhydra lutris</i>	Common locally
Harbor seal, <i>Phoca vitulina</i>	Abundant
Northern sea lion, <i>Eumetopias jubatus</i>	Uncommon (August-April)
California sea lion, <i>Zalophus californianus</i>	Uncommon (March-April)
Northern elephant seal, <i>Mirounga angustirostris</i>	Rare
Gray whale, <i>Eschrichtius robustus</i>	Common (spring and fall)
Minke whale, <i>Balaenoptera acutorostrata</i>	Uncom. (summer and fall)
Humpback whale, <i>Megaptera novaeangliae</i>	Uncommon (fall)
Harbor porpoise, <i>Phocoena phocoena</i>	Common locally (summer)
Killer whale, <i>Orcinus orca</i>	Uncommon (summer and fall)
Dall's porpoise, <i>Phocoenoides dalli</i>	Uncommon
Pacific white-sided dolphin, <i>Lagenorhynchus obliquidens</i>	Uncommon
