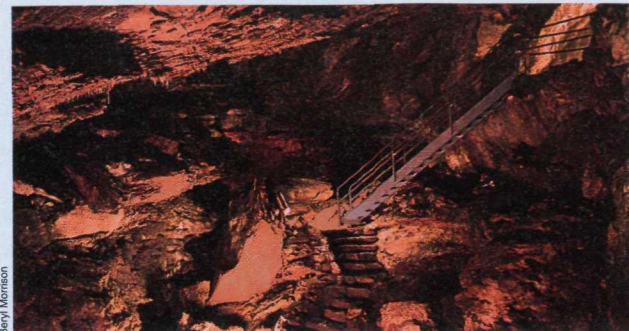

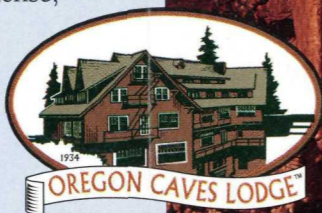

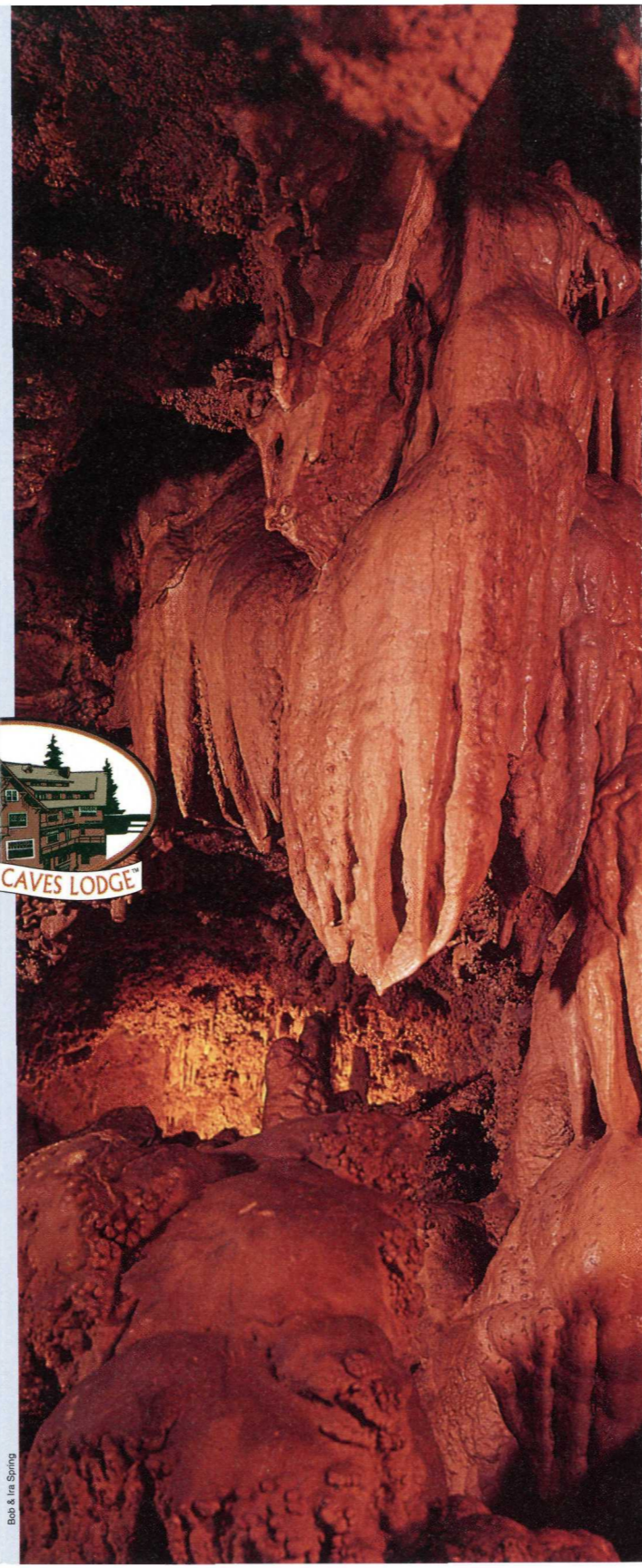
*480 acres of marble

Outside, you'll find a world of gargantuan trees and the most delicate of flowers.

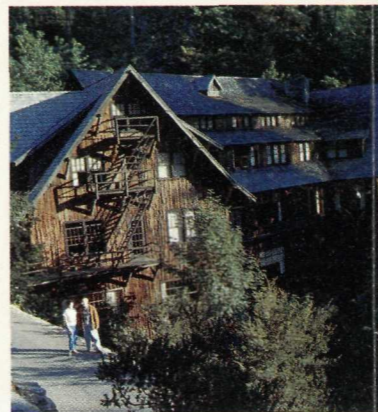

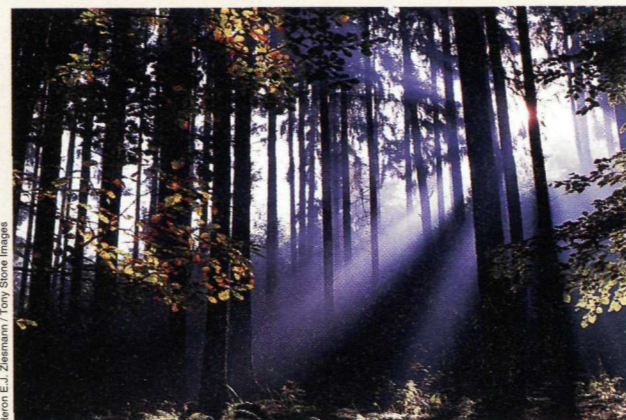

Our well-maintained trails to mountain tops and ancient forests will yield many more discoveries.



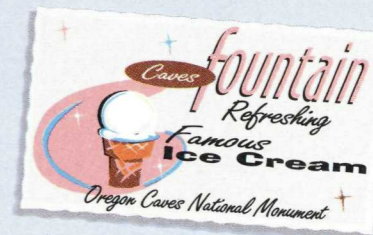

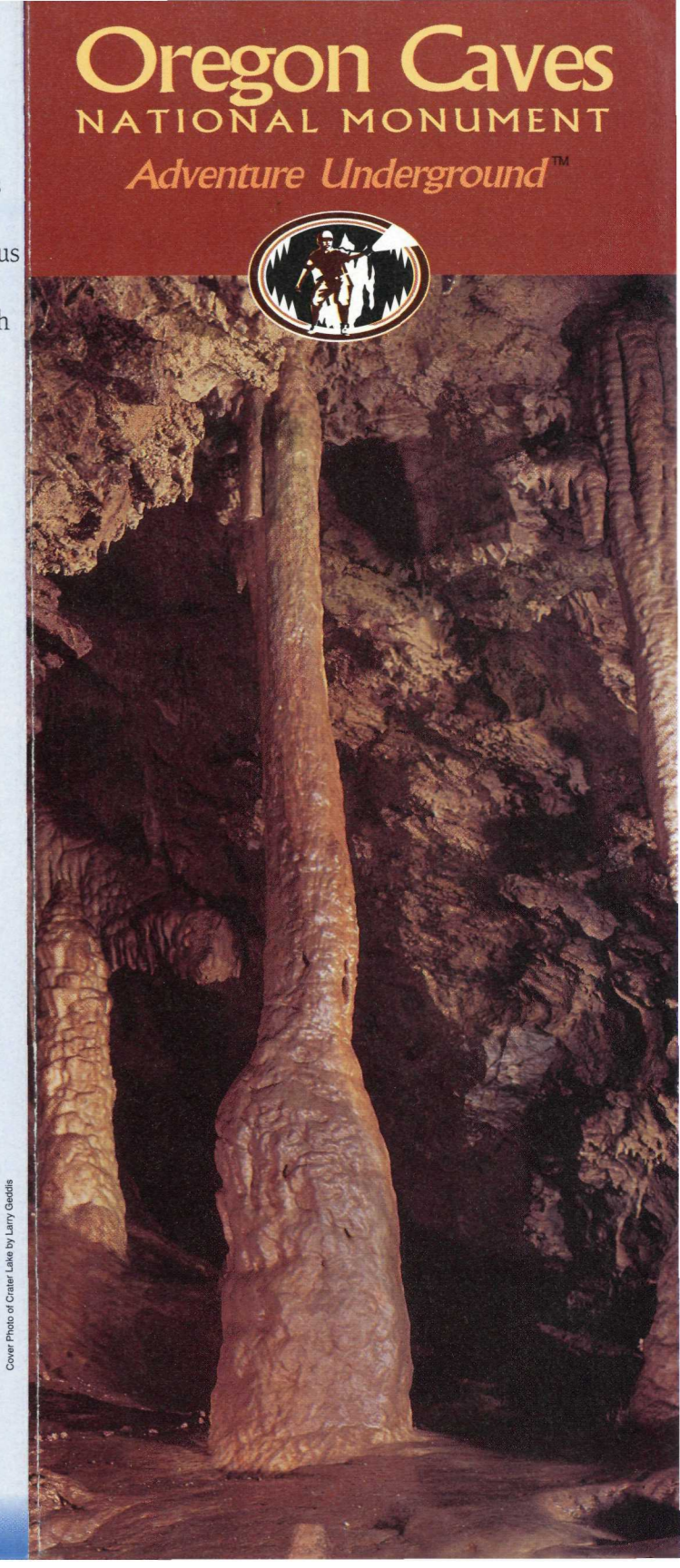
