Cave Tour Schedule

March 21 to Memorial Day weekend 10 am – 4 pm*

No Cave Tours April 6 – April 24

After Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day 9 am – 6 pm

After Labor Day to Columbus Day 10 am – 5 pm

After Columbus Day to first Saturday in November 10 am – 4 pm

Early November to late May: **No Cave Tours offered**

Fees

15 years and younger \$7.50 per person

16 years and older \$10.00 per person

Children must be 42" inches tall to go on tour (see below).

About the Cave Tour — 15 person limit per tour

The 80-minute cave tour is moderately strenuous and is not recommended for people with heart, breathing or walking problems. The 0.6-mile (1 km) route includes more than 500 stairs. Many stairs are steep, uneven and wet. The low, passageways require bending and twisting while walking. The temperature inside the cave is 44°F (7°C) year-round.

Be Prepared for your Cave Tour

Wear warm clothing and hiking shoes. Cameras with flash units allowed. No backpacks or tripods permitted due to low ceilings and narrow passageways. The cave has lighting; no personal flashlights.

Children

For safety, to go on a full cave tour children must be at least 42" inches tall. Children may not be carried through the cave.

Help us Protect our Bats!

White Nose Syndrome is devastating bat populations throughout the eastern U.S. and Canada. To prevent it spreading to the Oregon Caves, do not bring clothes or equipment used in other caves or mines east of the Rocky Mountains. Expect clothing and equipment screening at the Monument. Accessibility

Only the first room of the cave tour is accessible to persons with mobility impairments, including wheelchairs. People with knee injuries or similar concerns are not advised to take the tour.

Avoid Long Waits for Cave Tours

Arrive early to avoid long waits, especially during July and August.

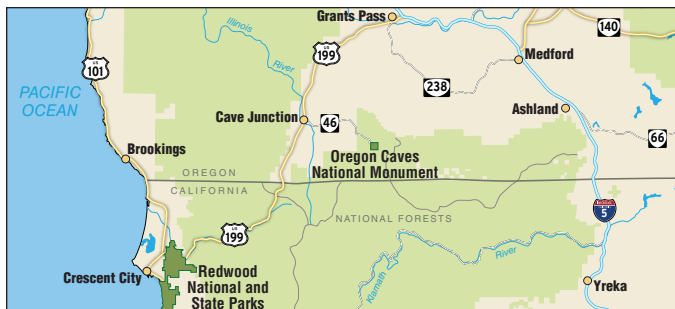
Other Activities
