



Bicycle Use

Regulations.

Under National Park Service (NPS) regulations, bicycles are treated like any other vehicle. They are subject to NPS and state motor vehicle laws. Bicycles are restricted to designated roadways, such as paved roads, Ajo Mountain and Puerto Blanco Scenic Drives. Bicycle use on foot trails or cross-country is strictly prohibited.

Traffic Law Exceptions.

Cyclists are not required to observe one-way traffic directions on the scenic loop drives.

Safety.

- Cycle defensively Speeding traffic on Highway #85 is dangerous. At all times be alert for vehicular traffic and other hazards on the Monument's narrow, winding roads.
- Wear your helmet and other personal protective gear.
- Carry and consume plenty of water. At least one gallon per person per day is recommended.
- Travel single file to allow room for both you and motorized vehicles.
- Mountain bikes are recommended for travel on the scenic drives.
