

- Entrance Fee \$3.00 per car; buses, cyclists, pedestrians \$1.00 per person; no fee with Golden Age, Golden Access, or Golden Eagle pass. Fee is good for 7 days.
- Visitor Center Open every day of the year, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Bookstore, museum, slide programs and information.
- Ranger Programs Interpretive activities including walks, demonstrations, and evening campfire programs are offered daily in the winter months (usually late Dec. through March).
- Main Campground Open daily. Fee \$8.00 per night; \$4.00 per night with Golden Age or Golden Access pass. No hook-ups; water and dump station available. Generator use permitted only between 12:00 noon and 5:00 p.m. Usually fills every night mid-January to late March, often by mid-morning. No advance reservations. (When park campgrounds are full, space may be available in private campgrounds in Lukeville or Why.)
- Alamo Primitive Campground No fee. Backcountry permit required: obtain at visitor center. Tent camping only. No water available. Limited to four sites; may fill very early, especially in winter months. No advance reservations.
- Backcountry Camping No fee. Backcountry permit required: obtain at visitor center. Must camp at least half a mile away from any road.
- Scenic Drives: Two gravel roads, frequently washed out by rain July - October. Best to call park at (602) 387-6849 to check road status before arrival at that season.
