DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The mill building in front of Cave Spring was in a serious state of deterioration when visited in April of 1969. Portions of the building had been torn away for firewood. The floor and main support timbers are still in good condition.

The rock work in front of the spring opening is in good condition and the point where the trough for the mill race was located is clearly visible.

The site is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19 T26NR2E.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The grist mill at Cave Spring was one of several along the Current River that were operated by the water gushing from the natural springs that feed the river. While the Alley Spring Mill has been maintained, the smaller structure at Cave Springs has been allowed to decay.
