The segment of road that passes along the edge of Pulltite Campground is still very distinct. Though grass has grown over it and bushes are beginning to infringe on the roadway, the lane is still easily seen and in the campground area is tree shaded. Near the river the trail or road is a bit less well defined.

On the attached map the road is marked at four places near the campground. Originally it ran from Cedargrove on the north to Round Spring on the south. The condition of the remainder of the road is not known.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The road from Cedargrove to Round Spring was used by settlers in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries for trips to town or local grist mills. Following the river, switching from one bank to the other as the terrain demanded, the road or trail was used by the residents in their unhurried lives.
