Nampaweap is thought to have been a passageway used by native peoples for migrating from the Grand Canyon to the higher elevation Ponderosa pine forests located at Mt. Trumbull. Hundreds of petroglyphs, known as rock writing, have been carved into the smooth surface of the basalt rock.
