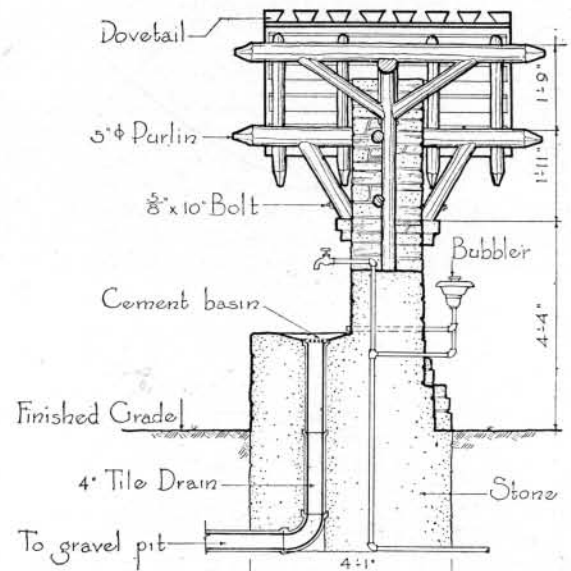




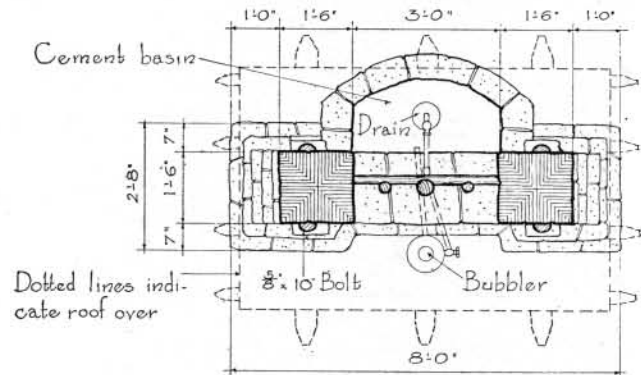
Drinking Fountain

McCormick's Creek State Park - - - Indiana

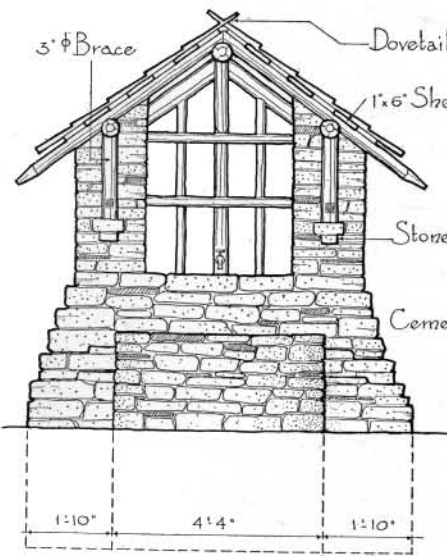

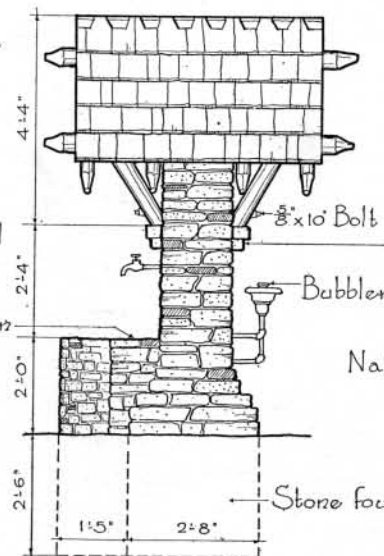

PLAN

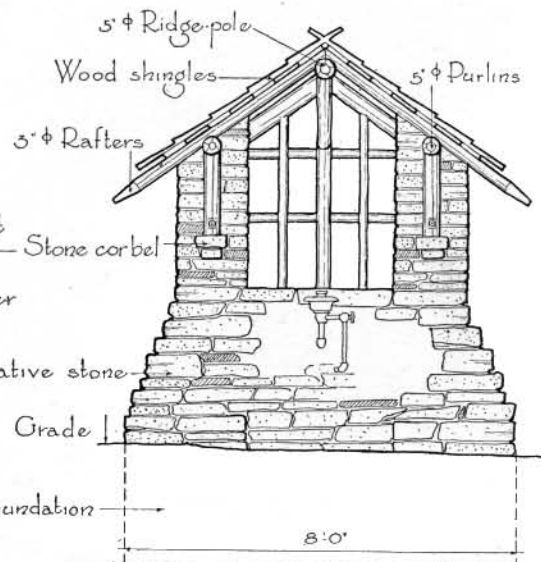


FRONT ELEVATION
