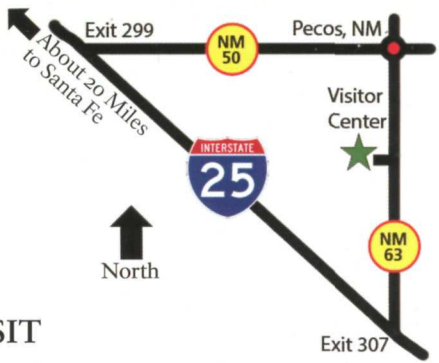


For thousands of years,
