## Campgrounds in Marin County and along the Sonoma Coast

#### Point Reyes National Seashore

Visit www.recreation.gov or call 1-877-444-6777 for reservations. Only backcountry campgrounds, located 1.4 to 6.3 miles from nearest trailheads, and boat-in sites on Tomales Bay are available. No drive-in campgrounds. Permits required and may be obtained at the Bear Valley Visitor Center. \$20 per site/night for up to 6 people, \$40 or \$50 per group site/night for up to 25 people. No pets.

### Samuel P. Taylor State Park - Camp Taylor

Six miles east of the Bear Valley Visitor Center on Sir Francis Drake Blvd., west of Lagunitas. \$8 day use fee. 61 family sites, \$35 per night, 8 person maximum per site, \$8 charge for second vehicle. Hiker and bicyclist campsites: \$5 per person per night, one night limit. 5 group sites: \$35 for 10 person sites, \$75 for 20 person horse camp, \$110 for 25 person group site, \$225 for 50 person site. 4 cabins: \$100/cabin/night. \$8 day use fee. No fee for dogs. Accessible campsites and restrooms with showers available. Reservations accepted and recommended April 1 – Labor Day Weekend. #### Golden Gate National Recreation Area

Kirby Cove – 4 drive-up group campsites. \$25/night, 2 to 10 people per site. Campsites are handicap accessible. For reservations, call 1-877-444-6777 or go to http://www. recreation.gov/.

For reservations at the following three campgrounds, call (415) 331-1540, 9 am - 4:30 pm up to 90 days in advance.

Haypress – 5 hike-in campsites. Free. Maximum of four people per site. Hike in 0.75 miles from the Tennessee Valley parking lot.

Hawk – 3 hike-in campsites. Free. Maximum of four people per site. Hike in 3 miles from the Tennessee Valley Parking lot or 3.5 miles from the Headlands Visitor Center.

Bicentennial – 3 walk-in campsites. Free. Maximum of two people per site. Located 100 yards from road.

### Olema Campground

http://www.olemacampground.net/ (415) 663-8106 or (855) 396-7193. One mile from the Bear Valley Visitor Center, on Highway One in Olema. Privately owned. 202 campsites. Summer (5/1 - 9/30) rates: full hookups - \$53 per night Su-Th / \$63 per night Fr, Sa & holidays; tent sites - \$44 per night Su-Th / \$49 per night Fr, Sa & holidays. Spring (3/1 - 4/30) rates & fall (10/1 - 11/30) rates: full hook-ups - \$50 per night; tent sites - \$42 per night. Winter (12/1 - 2/28) rates: full hook-ups - \$45 per night; tent sites -\$40 per night. Rates include two people (age 2+), one pet, and one vehicle per night. Maximum six persons, two vehciles, and two pets per site. Holiday weekends require three night minimum stay. \$3 per each extra person for tent camping, \$1.50 per each extra persons for RV camping, \$2 per extra vehicle. \$5 for showers for non-campers. Laundromat and post office.

(707) 878-2443. 21 miles northwest of the Bear Valley Visitor Center, off Highway One in Dillon Beach, at the north end of Tomales Bay. Privately owned. Reservations required. 140 sites. \$30 per night for tent sites, \$35 per night for trailer sites. \$20 per night for a second car. \$8 day use fee (closes at 6 pm). Restrooms available. No hook-ups or showers.

1-800-992-CAMP. 25 miles northeast of the Bear Valley Visitor Center, on the corner of Stony Point and Rainsville Roads in Petaluma. 312 sites, accommodates tents or RV's. Privately owned. Rates are for double occupancy and do not include tax. Full hookup: \$49.75 to \$80. Tent site: \$29.95 to \$50.75. Kamping Kabins: \$60 to \$105. \$7 per additional adult, \$5 per additional child. Kamping lodge: \$125 to \$199 per nite for four people. Showers, laundry, store, pool, playground, club room, dog walk, dump station. Disabled access.

### China Camp State Park - Back Ranch Campground

San Pedro Road, along San Pablo Bay. 30 walk-in (100-400 yds) tent sites. \$35 per night. \$5 day use fee. No fee for dogs. Potable water, restrooms, and showers available. Camping reservations can be made all year-round by calling RESERVAMERICA at 1-800-444-7275 or visiting http://www.reserveamerica.com/.

### Mount Tamalpais State Park

Pantoll Campground – 21 miles south of the Bear Valley Visitor Center, on Panoramic Highway. 16 walk-in (100 yards) tent sites. 8 person limit per site. Self-contained vehicles can stay one night in the parking lot between 6 p.m. and 9 a.m. \$25 per night, first come, first served; self-registration. Restrooms, water, firewood.

Steep Ravine Cabins – One mile south of Stinson Beach. 10 rustic cabins and 6 hike-in campsites. \$100 per cabin per night/\$25 per tent site. Five people and one vehicle per site or cabin. Primitive toilets, water, and firewood nearby. No pets. Reservation only, call RESERVAMERICA at 1-800-444-7275 or go to http://www.reserveamerica.com/.

#### **Doran Regional Park**

http://www.sonoma-county.org/parks/pk\_doran.htm (707) 875-3540. 34 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center, at the south end of Bodega Bay. 132 tent/RV sites. 8 person limit per site. \$32 per night, \$7 per extra vehicle per night, \$2 per dog per night. Sonoma County residents and people with permanent disabilities may be eligible for discounted rates. One group campsite for up to 50 people, \$150 per night. \$7 day use fee. Potable water, accessible restrooms, showers, dump station, boat ramp. No hook-ups. For reservations, call (707) 565-CAMP.

#### Westside Regional Park

http://www.sonoma-county.org/parks/pk\_wstsd.htm (707) 875-3540. 36 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center on Highway One, at the north end of Bodega Bay. 47 tent/RV sites; for rates and reservation information see Doran Regional Park above. Potable water, accessible restrooms, showers, dump station, boat ramp. No hook-ups.

#### Sonoma Coast State Beaches

Call RESERVAMERICA at 1-800-444-7275 or go to http://www.reserveamerica.com for reservations for Bodega Dunes or Wright's Beach. Due to service reductions, Willow Creek and Pomo Canyon Environmental Campgrounds are closed until further notice.

Bodega Dunes – 35 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center on Highway One. 98 campsites. \$35 per night per site. \$8 for a second vehicle. \$5 per person for hike-in/bike-in campsite. Accessible showers. Dump station. No hook-ups.

Wright's Beach – 41 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center on Highway One. 27 campsites adjacent to the beach. \$35-45 per night. \$8 per extra vehicle per night. Trailers and RV's limited to 27 ft in length. Flush toilets. Potable water. No showers, no hook-ups.

Willow Creek Environmental Campground – 44 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center on Highway One, then 0.5 miles east on Willow Creek Road. 11 walk-in (300 feet to 1/2 mile from parking) tent sites. \$25 per night per site. \$8 per extra vehicle per night. Pit toilets. No water. No pets.

Pomo Canyon Environmental Campground – 44 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center on Highway One, then 2.5 miles east on Willow Creek Road. 20 walk-in (200 feet to 1/2 mile) tent sites. \$25 per night per site. \$8 per extra vehicle per night. Potable water. Pit toilets. No pets.

### Fort Ross Reef Campground

Due to service reductions, Reef Campground is closed until further notice.

(707) 847-3286. 51 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center, on Highway One. 19 campsites, 8 person limit per site. \$25 per night per site. \$10 per extra vehicle per night (2 car limit). \$8 day use fee. No fees for dogs. No trailers; vehicles limited to 18 feet in length. Coastal access, flush toilets, potable water.

#### **Austin Creek State Recreation Area**

http://www.parks.ca.gov/?page\_id=452 (707) 869-2015. 65 miles north of the Bear Valley Visitor Center. 24 tent/RV campsites at Bullfrog Pond Campground. 3 hike-in (3 to 5 miles) sites (1 at Tom King and 2 at Manning Flats). 8 person limit per site. \$25 per night. \$8/extra vehicle/night. \$8 day use fee. Potable water and flush toilets at drive-in campground; pit toilets at hike-in campsites. No showers. No trailers; vehicles limited to 20 feet in length. No pets. First come, first served. Must occupy the site at time of use.
