Your recent postcard to Attorney General Kennedy concerning the President's request for funds for addition park and recreation areas, and the use of the Salmon River in northern California as a recreation area has been referred to us for consideration.

We believe that there is a definite need for additional park and recreation opportunities across the country. The enclosed brochure lists the current proposals and illustrates the national scope of the undertaking.
