MEMORANDUM for the Regional Director, Region Four.

Attached are a deed and some other papers concerning a proposal on the part of Mrs. May Steinhauer of Eureka, California, to donate a considerable acreage of Redwood forest land to the United States.

You will note that I have written to Mrs. Steinhauer, returning all of her papers because we are not now in a position to consider her offer, and suggesting that she communicate with the California State Park Commission. You should see the papers referred to, and may desire to discuss the matter with the Director and the State authorities. Apparently, Mrs. Steinhauer's property would be of interest to the State's program.

If you feel that my letter to Mrs. Steinhauer is satisfactory, it can be sent on from your office, together with the deed and other papers, except her letter to the Secretary which should be returned here with certain file copies as indicated. If my letter is not satisfactory, you should rewrite it for your signature, or the Director's if he is available, and return her letter to the Secretary, together with our copies of the supplanting letter.
