ALAMOGORDO (Continued)

Alamogordo is the headquarters of Lincoln National Forest, where 30,000 head of cattle and 10,000 sheep are grazed. The city's mills are supplied with logs from the Sacramento and Sierra Blanca mountain forests, which are located near Cloudcroft and Ruidoso.

THE PICTOGRAPHS, 35 miles north on U.S. 54, then about 4 miles east of Three Rivers, are about 800 years old. This is said to be one of the country's largest groups of picture writings.
