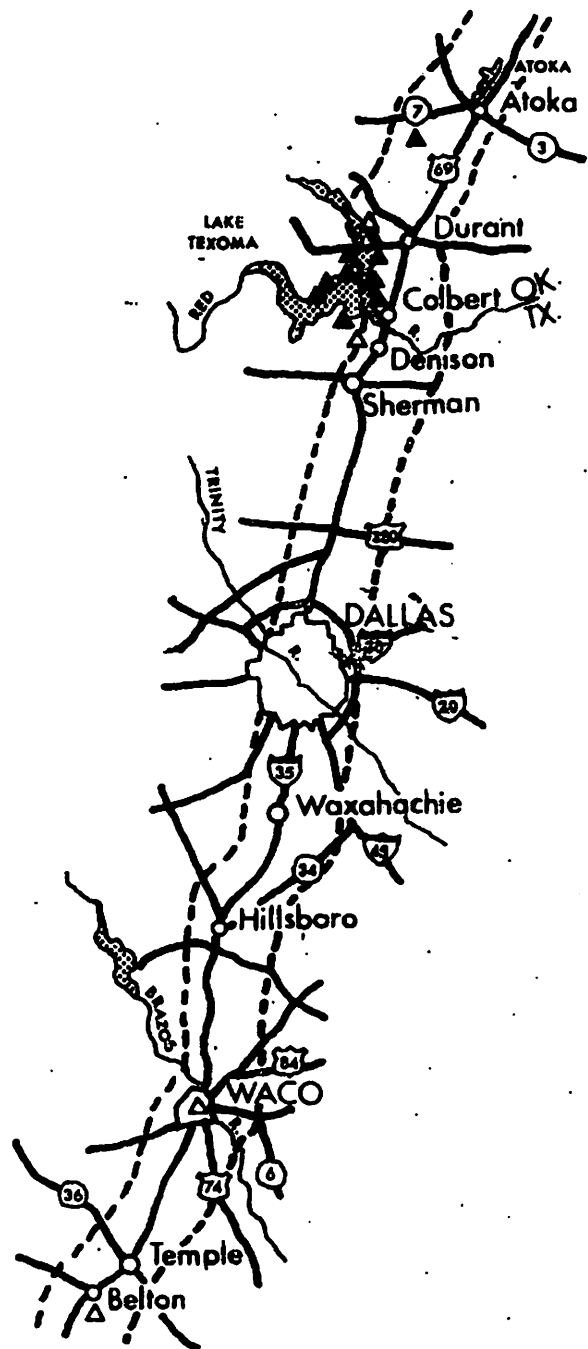

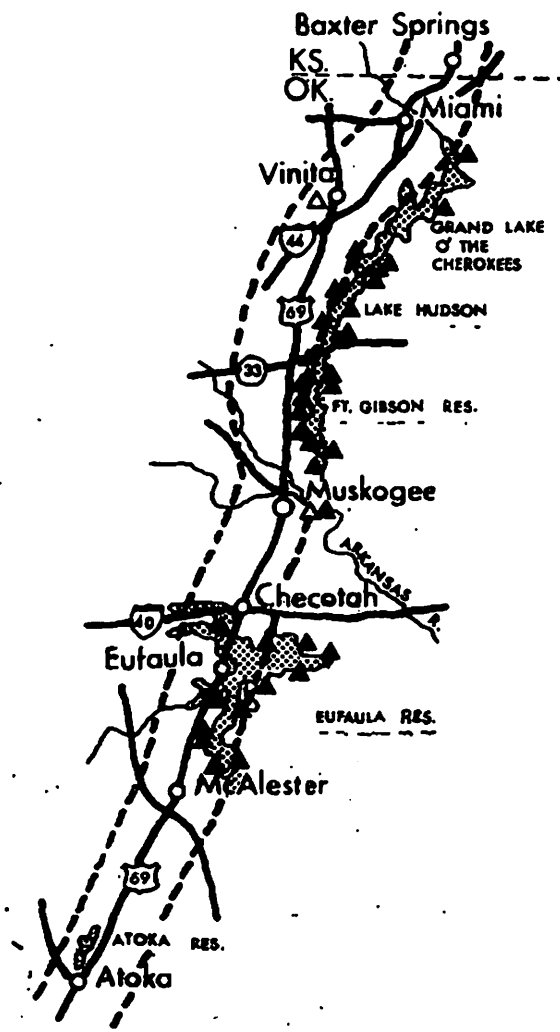
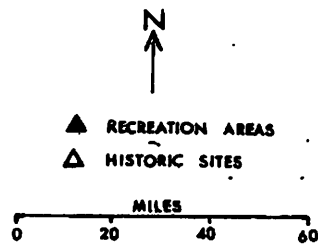

Atoka, Oklahoma, to Baxter Springs, Kansas

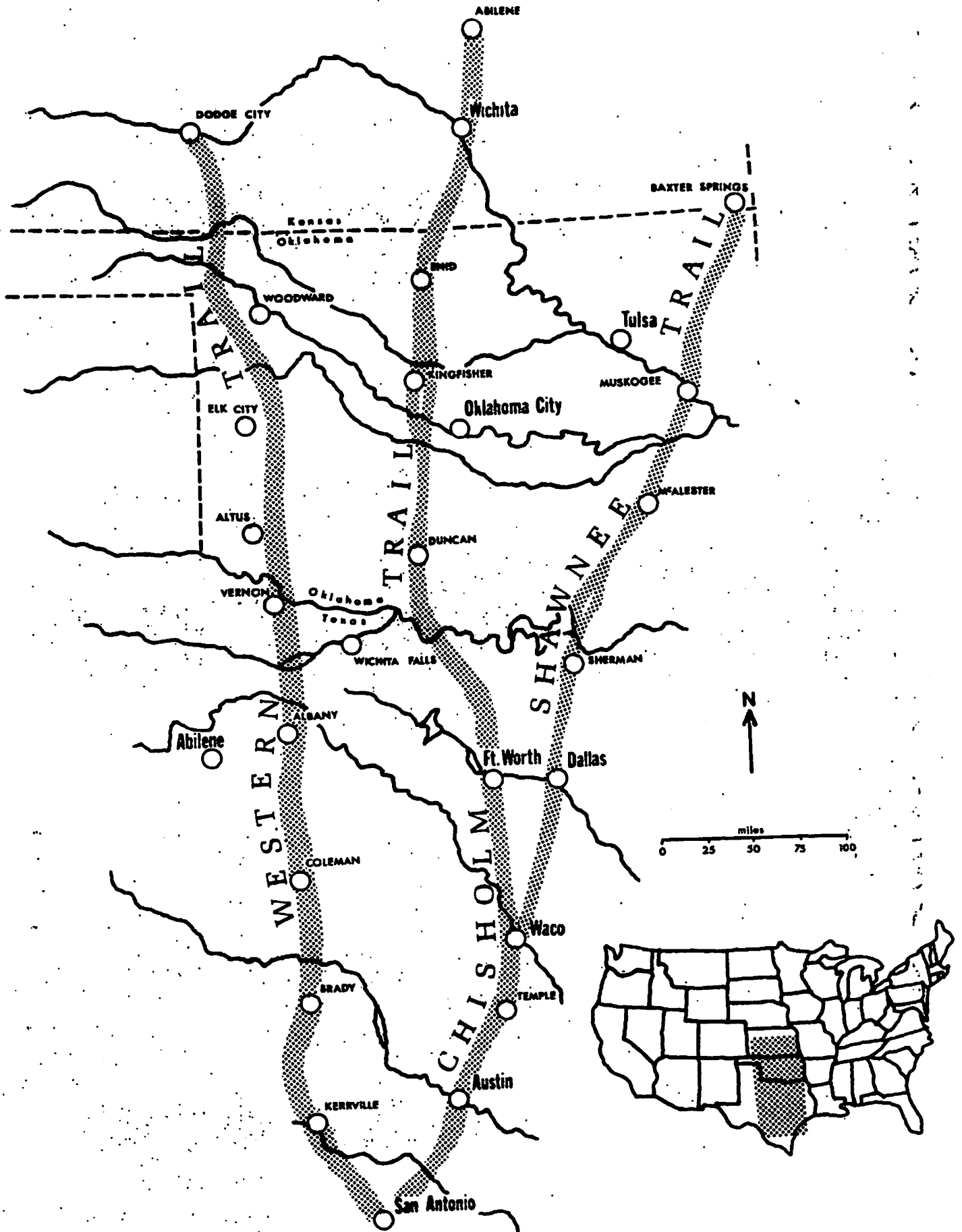
