From information which I have received from those who made the exploration, it would seem as if this cavern might be something well worthy of preservation.

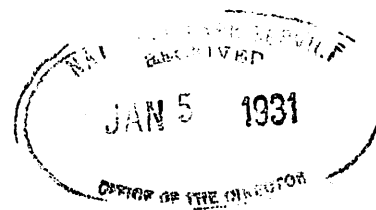
