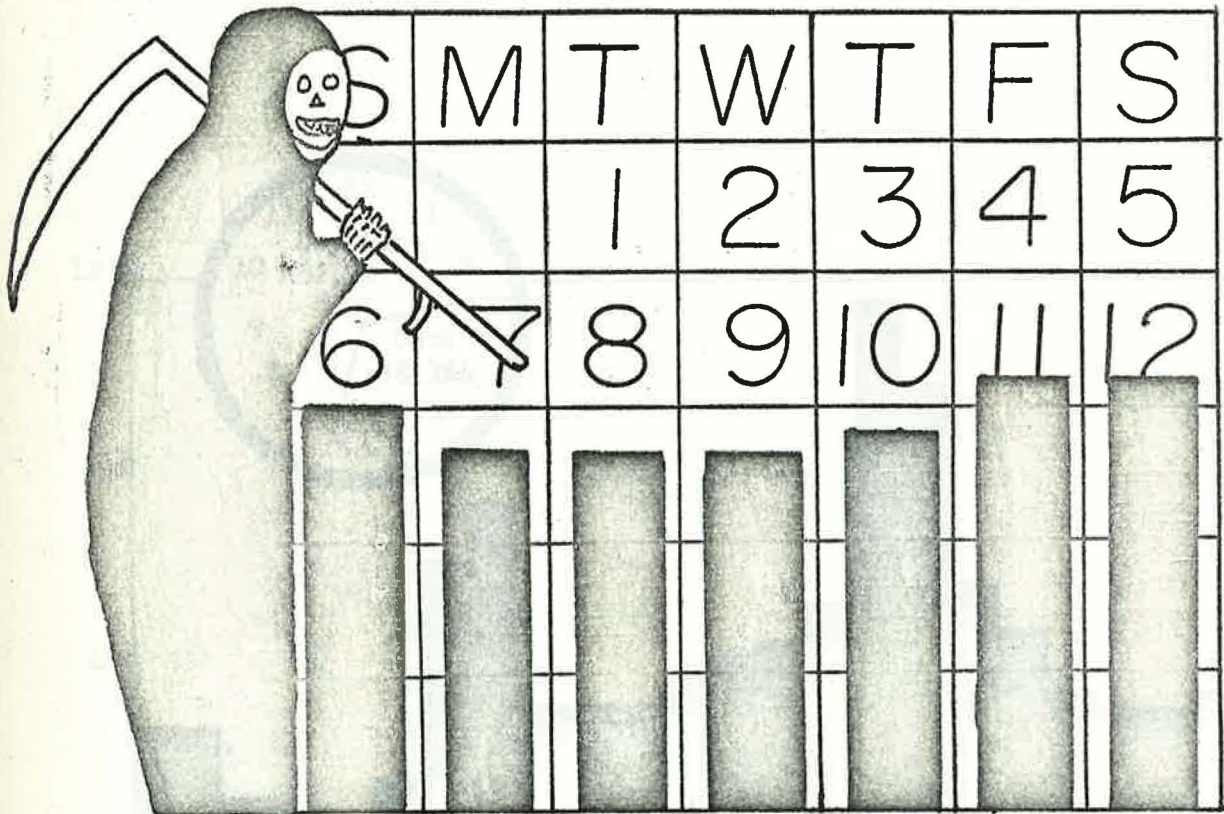


ACCIDENTS, BY DAY OF WEEK

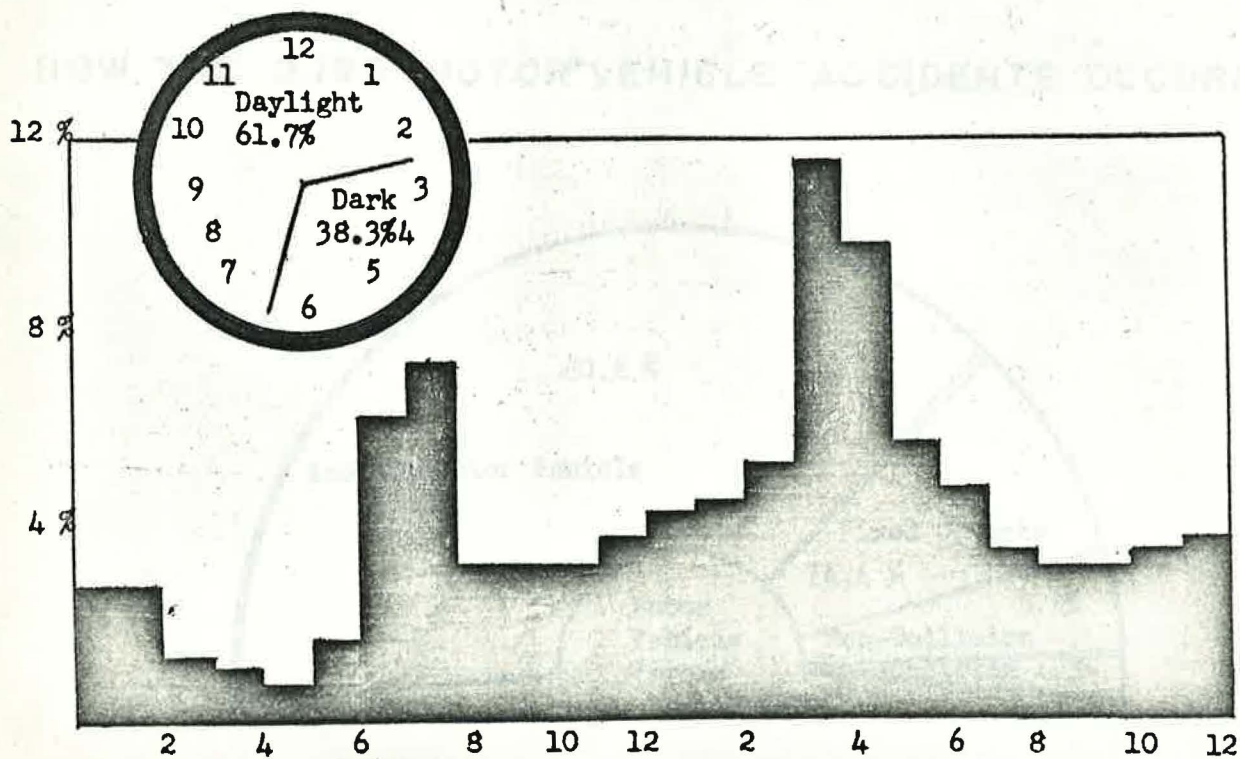

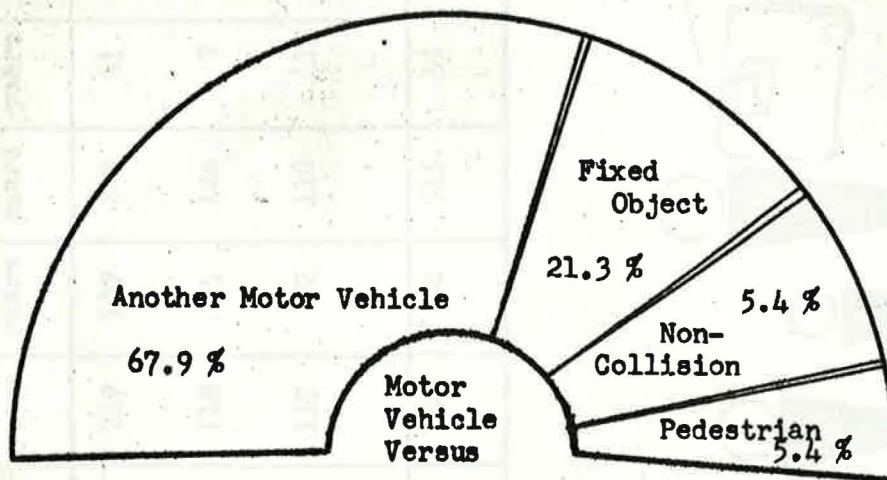

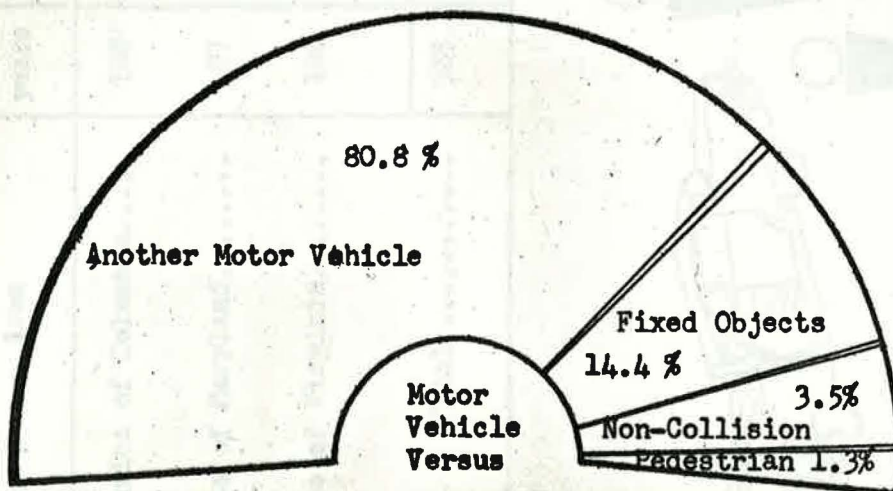

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS OCCURRED

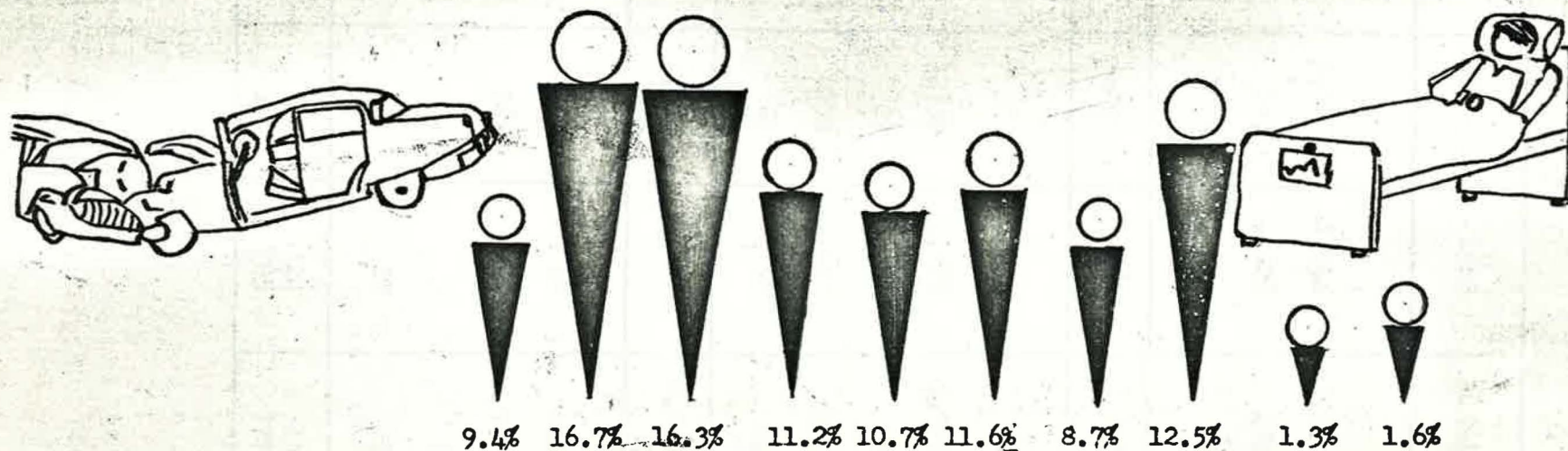


HOW THE 2,196 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS OCCURRED

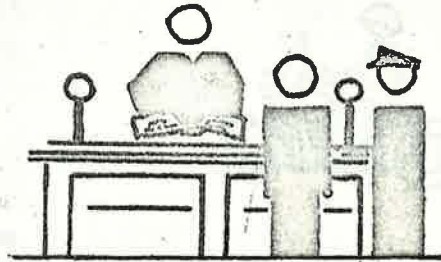
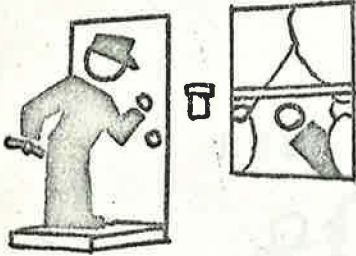

Special Occasions and Events

Some idea of the enormity of the task which confronts the Force can be perceived by considering the many civic and social events held within the park system each year and for which the Park Police have primary protective responsibility - the Cherry Blossom Festival, Pageant and Parade, the Independence Day Celebration, the President's Cup Regatta, the School Safety Patrol Parade and many others - each of which attracts hundreds of thousands of spectators. During 1964 there were 479 such Special Details with 3,217 individual assignments to such public functions were made involving a utilization of 14,481 man hours.
