Species: Eastern Box Turtle

Found in the eastern United States these terrestrial* turtles primary habitats are forests, meadows, and swamps. Opportunistic omnivores** favorite foods include: flowers, roots, snails, worms, fish, and even

carrion***. Red eyes are a distinguishable trait of males as females have yellowish brown eyes.

Females will nest in summer laying between 3 to 8 eggs at a time.

Lifespans of eastern box turtles have been known to reach up to 100 years.
