## **Pioneer for Union Rights**

## Joe James, Welder at Marinship, Sausalito, CA

African American shipyard workers paid union dues but could not join the union with Whites. Instead they were assigned to a segregated, powerless "auxiliary". Over 950 African American workers at Marinship protested and were fired in 1943. Joe James sued. The California Supreme Court agreed with him that closedshop unions couldn't exclude people based on race (1945).
