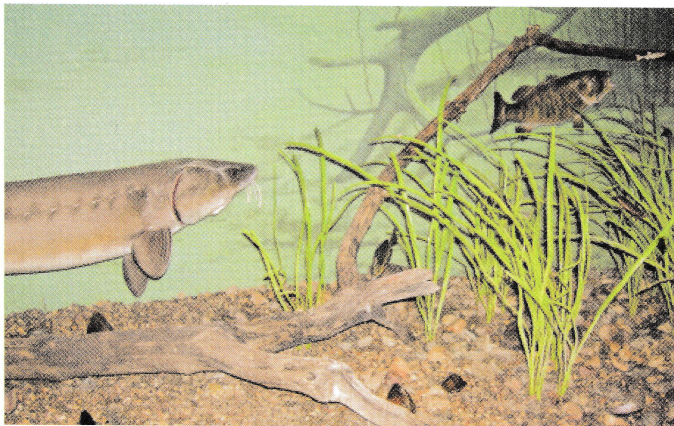




Namekagon River Visitor Center

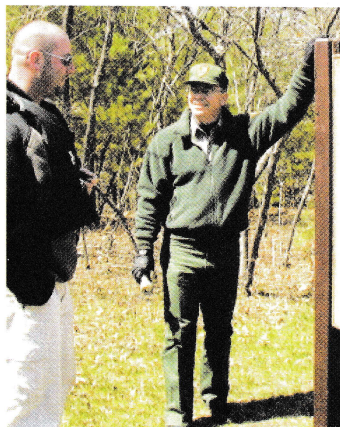
