As a young girl, Mochi escaped the horror of the Sand Creek Massacre. She rose among the Cheyenne people to become a woman warrior. In 1875, she and her husband, Medicine Water, were exiled by the US Army to Fort Marion, St. Augustine, making her the only Cheyenne Woman Warrior held as a prisoner in Florida.
