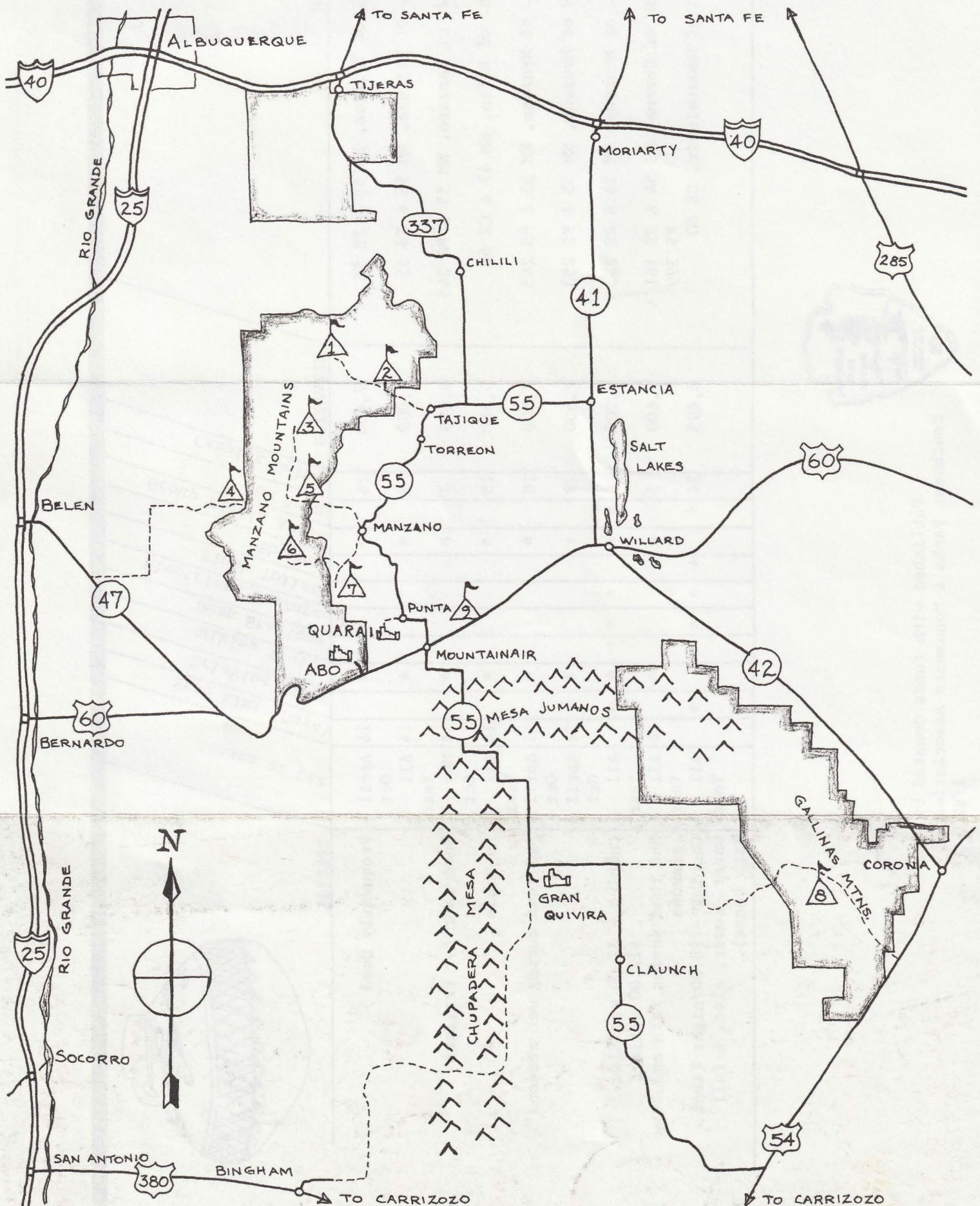
Camping

Camping within Salinas Pueblo Missions National Monument or on private land surrounding the ruins is not allowed.

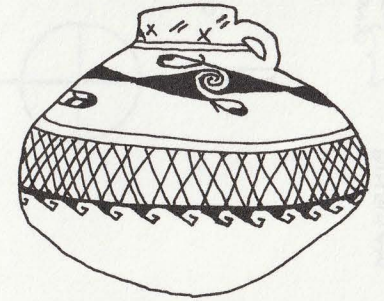
The US Forest Service operates 6 campgrounds and many hiking trails in the Manzano Mtns, and one campground in the Gallinas Mtns near Gran Quivira.
