



General Albert Sidney Johnston

Confederate Commander at Shiloh Johnston was the supreme Confederate commander in the Western Theater of the Civil War (west of the Appalachian Mountains). He led his army into the Battle of Shiloh and was killed the first day, April 6, 1862, bleeding to death from a leg wound. He remains the highest ranking American officer ever to be killed in combat.
