Visitor Services Project Database

The pilot phase of the VSP Database was completed in February 1994. During the pilot phase, selected clients were able to access the database through Nancy Medlin. Clients were asked to evaluate the pilot database in terms of its usefulness and efficiency, and make recommendations on how it could be improved. A report on the results of their evaluations and a proposal on how the database should proceed are being prepared by Nancy Mediin and Dr. Machlis.

Belle Haven/Dyke Marsh video report

The Belle Haven/Dyke Marsh video report, which is a videotape that will be used to compliment the Belle Haven/Dyke Marsh written report, was completed by Dwight Madison and the UI College of Forestry media lab. It will be sent to the George Washington Memorial Parkway in May 1994.

Special Report On Customer Services

Serving the Visitor: A Report on Customers of the National Park Service, by Dr. Machlis and Nancy Medlin, is being published in May, 1994. This booklet presents park visitors quality ratings of twelve different visitor services, from campgrounds to interpretive programs. The information for the report comes from the VSP database, and represents survey responses from over 18,000 visitor groups in 44 units of the NPS. The booklet will be distributed throughout the park system.
