Tours are available November through April, Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays.

- Check-in at the Visitor Center by 9:45 a.m. Tours begin promptly at 10:00 a.m.
- Call for Reservations.

 groups larger than 6 need
 multiple reservations. Limit of
 15 people per tour. Reservations
 for the season can be made
 starting on October 1st.

The Trail:

- 3 miles (5 km) round trip
- 600 feet (200 meter) elevation gain
- Hike lasts 3–4 hours, with a brief snack break.

Be Prepared:

- •Bring plenty of water, sunscreen, a hat, and a snack.
- •Stairs and loose rocks are common, please bring sturdy shoes.
- Be aware of bees,if you are allergic, please bring emergency medication.
- Restrooms are not available
- Children under 8 years are not recommended.
- Pets are not allowed on this trail.
