Education in the Field

The aim of the Moveable School was to share and expand the agricultural knowledge of both black and white farmers. Originally, the mobile school was a horse-drawn wagon. It was later motorized and expanded to promote nutrition and recreation. During the summer of 1906, the mobile school serviced over 2,000 people per month.
