

Learn about volcanoes and cultural history in the Chitwood Exhibit Hall.

For panoramic views of Newberry Volcano and the Cascade Range drive or walk to top of the **Lava Butte** Volcano.

Enjoy a walk along the Lava Butte Rim, Trail of Molten Land or Trail of the Whispering Pines.



Visit Lava Lands and Paulina Visitor Center for ranger program schedules, area information and Discover Your Forest stores for maps, books, T-shirts and more.



At **Lava River Cave** explore another world below ground in Oregon's longest lava tube. Discover unique cave features left behind by a massive lava flow long ago.

Light rentals available at cave entrance.



A bit further south off Hwy 97, **Lava Cast Forest** offers an interpretive trail across a 7,000 year old basalt lava flow that enveloped a mature forest, leaving behind tree casts as the flow cooled.

Walk the **Big** Obsidian Flow

to explore volcanic glass and pumice among Oregon's youngest lava flow. Sleep in the volcano at Monument campgrounds and resorts.



Drive or hike

Paulina Peak, the highest point at 7,984' of Newberry Volcano for panoramic views of the High Cascades and **Newberry Caldera**.



View **Paulina Falls**, an 80' spring-fed waterfall plunging over volcanic cliffs.
