Resorts

Paulina Lake Lodge • East Lake Resort

Two full-service resorts which operate under special use permits from the Deschutes National Forest. In summer, both offer overnight lodging, boat rentals, boat launching, gas, groceries, camping supplies, fishing tackle, public phones, and restaurants (please check ahead to confirm operation times). East Lake Resort also has full hookups for campers and recreational vehicles at their park, showers, and laundry facilities. Paulina Lake Lodge is open year-round and provides many services to winter recreationists.
